Registered Apprenticeship programs?

Keystone Development Partnership recently launched the Registered Apprenticeship (RA) Navigator program to help expand apprenticeship programs throughout Pennsylvania. The one-year apprenticeship program includes 2,000 hours of on-the-job training (OJT) plus 144 hours of Related Technical Instruction (RTI), provided in part by Penn State University. The goal is to develop the **Keystone Apprenticeship Alliance** - a network of intermediaries able to assist unions and employers to expand apprenticeship programs into new occupations and industries.

Funded by the PA Department of Labor & Industry through the PAsmart Initiative, the program recently received the Pinnacle for Business Development Award, presented by the National Association of State Workforce Agencies (NASWA) in recognition of its innovation and value.
