The following is a forwarded message from Elie Waldman:

Dear community member,

Many of us cannot think of Shabbos without the Eruv, although very few of us consider the tremendous efforts and substantial costs that are associated with running a proper Eruv. Each week, it takes over 10 hours to simply check the Eruv. This is followed by the maintenance team repairing the checker's findings each Thursday night and Friday (sometimes up to candle-lighting time!). This has to happen every single week, rain or shine.

Each shul in the community is asked to have its members contribute towards covering this budget. The costs of the eruv - checkers, maintenance, materials, insurance, etc - are covered almost entirely by these contributions. This week, our shul is focused on doing our part to ensure the viability of one of our community's essential amenities that we all benefit from.
