This year Lent began on March 05 with Ash Wednesday. There are 40 days of Lent. Lent is time for extra prayer, sacrifices and acts of kidness especially for poor people. Favorite lenten prayer forms are: bible reading, stations of the cross and daily mass.

Show the children the graces we gain with the Sacrament of Reconciliation. 







WALKING BY FAITH

Soint & Patrick Misisonary Bishop Feast Day: March 17 St. Patrick, the great patron of Ireland, was actually born in Britain, the son of a deacon. In his early teens, Patrick was kidnapped and sold as a slave in Ireland. There he tended pigs and sheep for his master. He longed for his home and family, but learned to find peace through prayer. After six years, Patrick escaped. He went to Europe to live in a monastery. There he was ordained a priest and then a missionary bishop. His mission land was Ireland.
