

A deaf man hears again


September 7: 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Talk about the story

Speak with the children about what it is like not being able to listen or to speak. How would they feel? Do they know someone who is deaf and mute? What is it like playing deaf? Do they sometimes play deaf in oder not to do something the adults are asking of them? What would they like to tell someone, and they don't dare? Why is it sometimes they feel they cannot speak up?

You are there

Imagine you are deaf and mute. How do you comunicate with people? Imagine you are one of the friends of the man and you are accompanying him to see Jesus. Do you really think Jesus can heal your friend? How do you feel when he does?



S: Jesus healed a young man so that he could hear and speak. This man then heard all sorts of wonderful sounds. Do you listen to the people and sounds around you? Do you sometimes pretend not to hear?

>> Jesus opens the ears of people to hear what God wants of them. Do you sometimes play deaf to what your parents or adults say?


>> Jesus did everything well. Do you make and effort to do things well?




Jesus, your friend, invites you:

Rules for the game "The Tables of the Law"

How many people play?

As many people as you like. One person has to take care of reading the questions for the squares.

What do you need?

A dice, and one *Token* per player. You can copy the tokens at the bottom, color them and then glue them onto cardboard paper, if you fold the base then they can stand up on the board.

Cards with the Tables of the Law: Copy these cards onto thick paper, and give one to each player. You need a pencil in order to mark an X next to each Commandment that you get right.

Vouchers of Confession: Copy at least 10 or 15 of these onto thick paper.

Very Important!

Jesus doesn't like cheating, he wants you to learn and live the 10 Commandments. Be very honest, and when you play, put your card where everybody can see it, so that nobody may secretly mark a Commandment that they haven't known.


Who wins?


Whoever arrives to the finish first, having got right all of the 10 Commandments. If a player has arrived to the finish, but still has not got the 10 Commandments he/she must continue playing, but this time moving backwards; that's to say, from the finish until they arrive at the Commandments they are missing, and once they have them, they can start moving towards the finish.

Directions

You play by throwing the dice and moving the token along the footsteps. Each player must have a token a card with the tables of the Law and a pencil. The ten trees which are found on the board are also squares and they correspond to each one of the commandments of the law of God. If you fall on them, you have to say the commandment for which it asks you and if you get it right, you mark it an X on your card.

When a player falls on a tree and doesn't know the commandment, he/she goes back to the square
