Talk about the story. Talk with the children about the good traits that people around them have. Are these people patient with them? Are they happy, loving, generous? These are people that have the Spirit of Jesus. What makes the children afraid like Jesus' friends?

Activities and Prayer. Let the children draw and cut out tongues of fire. They can write their commitment on it, or the desire they have be patient, generous, or joyful. They can built a mobile with them. As they present their tongues of fire, all say: "Jesus, send us your spirit of love, joy, patience, generosity, and kindness."



Q: At Pentecost the Holy Spirit fills Jesus disciples with the courage to spread Jesus' love. Are you ever afraid to tell others about Jesus? Where do you get courage when you are feeling scared or weak?

You are there

What can you do as a friend of Jesus?

Jesus, your friend, invites you:

- God gives the Spirit of love and generosity to all. What do you share with others.

What am I going to do?

Speak to Jesus and tell him about who and what gives you courage. Tell him about the people with whom you want to share love and joy. Tell him what do want to do this week.

- For example: *I will help someone who is a new-comer in school, who is different from me, or seems scared.*
- For example: *When I am scared, I will try to remember that the Spirit of Jesus is with me.*

Talk about the story. How do they feel when they love another person so much that they feel they would like to be one with the person? Speak about the relationships of the family, of friends, and of the community, and of how we all need to be in relationships with other people in order to exist.

Do they know why Christians make the sign of the cross and say, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit? Remind them also of how the adults bless them when they go out, before they start something, or before going to bed. They place their children under God's protection.

Activities and Prayer. Renew the Baptismal promises and make the sign of the cross using blessed water. Pray: Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Jesus, your friend, invites you:

Are you among the disciples who believe, or among those who doubt?

You are there

Jesus tells us that there is only one God, ho is community: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

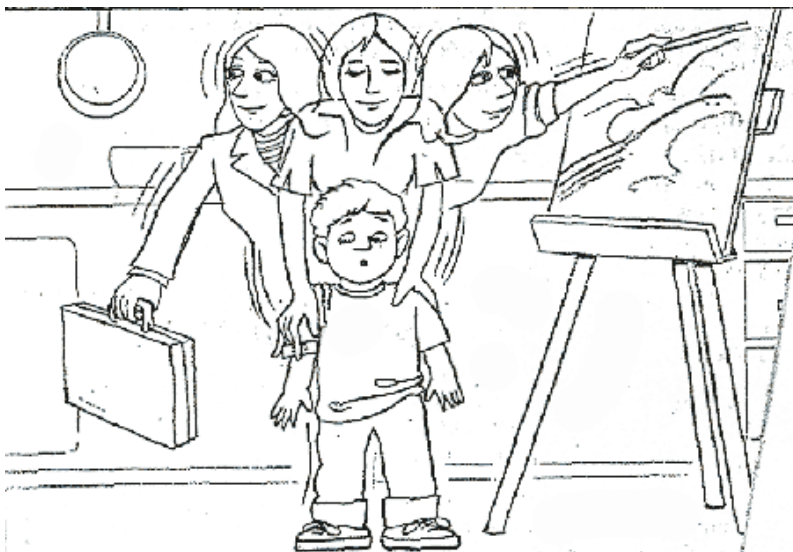
Do you remember your own baptism or have they told you, when they baptized you in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit?

Do you realize that you remember God every time you make the sign of the cross or when your parents, grandparents, or godparents bless you? What am I going to do?

Speak to Jesus and thank him because he has promised to always be with us to be good to one another. Tell him what do want to do this week.

- For example: *I will ask my godparents to tell me about my Baptism.*
- For example: *I will tell the adults in my home how much I love them.*

Jesus is with us as our Friend in the tabernacle

The Mass is a living memorial of Christ's Passion, Death and Resurrection. The Mass is a holy Banquet in which we receive Jesus and offer ourselves to the Father.

Today at Mass we remember Jesus' Last Supper and His death, and how God raised Jesus from the dead

The real presence of Our Lord in the Eucharistic is a sign of Jesus' love that we may receive Him as often as possible. To be able to do so one must:

- ☺ Be baptized in the Catholic Church and be in communion with the teaching of the Holy Father and the Magisterium of the Church.
- ☺ Be in state of grace, and therefore, confess any mortal sin; one must also receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least one a year and when in danger of imminent death.
- ☺ Abstain from food and drink (except water) one hour before receiving communion. This does not apply to the sick.
- ☺ Attend Mass on Sundays and on all Holy Days of obligation.

During the Eucharistic Celebration we offer bread and wine. As Jesus promised He becomes truly present in these gifts, through the words of the priest.

Talk about the story. With whom do they like to eat? What do they like about family meals and parties? What strikes them as interesting in the story of Jesus' Passover meal? Do they find it hard to share with others? What are they often asked to share? How do they react?

Activities and Prayer. Bring to class a large round loaf of bread and break it into several pieces. Give a piece to some of the children and ask them to share with others, making sure everyone gets some. Before eating it, all pray: Thank you, Jesus, for giving yourself up to us.

Jesus, your friend, invites you:

Jesus says that he gives up everything he is and has out of love for us. How do you answer him? Do you tell him you love him too and want to be with him always.

You are there

Do you understand Jesus' words about the bread and wine being his body and blood? What do you want to say to Jesus or what would you like to ask him about what he just said?

Do you eat the bread and drink the wine believing what Jesus says? What are you thinking? Where have you heard these words before?

What am I going to do?

Speak to Jesus and thank him for giving himself totally to us. Tell him you would like to share with others.

- For example: *I will lend my toys and my things without complaining.*
- For example: *I will share some of my time with an older person, helping her or keeping him company for a while.*

Talk about the story. Talk to the children about boats and storms. Have they ever been on a boat? What storms do they see around them? What is not going exactly as they would like it to?

Activities. Act out the scene of Jesus and his friends on the boat. Then act out a modern day scene where there is a big problem and Jesus gives them trust.

Final prayer. Have each child make a paper boat and write on it a problem or situation that worries him or her. When they express it, all respond: "Jesus, I know that you are with me, no matter what."

Jesus, your friend, invites you:

Do you think was really sleeping? Are you scared of the storm? What do you tell Jesus to wake him up?

You are there

Do you sometimes think that Jesus' doesn't hear your prayers when what you asked for doesn't happen? Today Jesus invites you to trust him. He wants you to remember that he can calm even the greatest of storms. What are the storms in your family and your life now? What situations frighten you?

What am I going to do?

Speak to Jesus and tell him about the problems you see at home or at school. Tell him you want to trust in him and ask him to help you this week.

- For example: *I will pray every night even if it seems that Jesus is asleep.*
- For example: *I will not get angry when I don't get immediate attention and I have to wait a little while.*

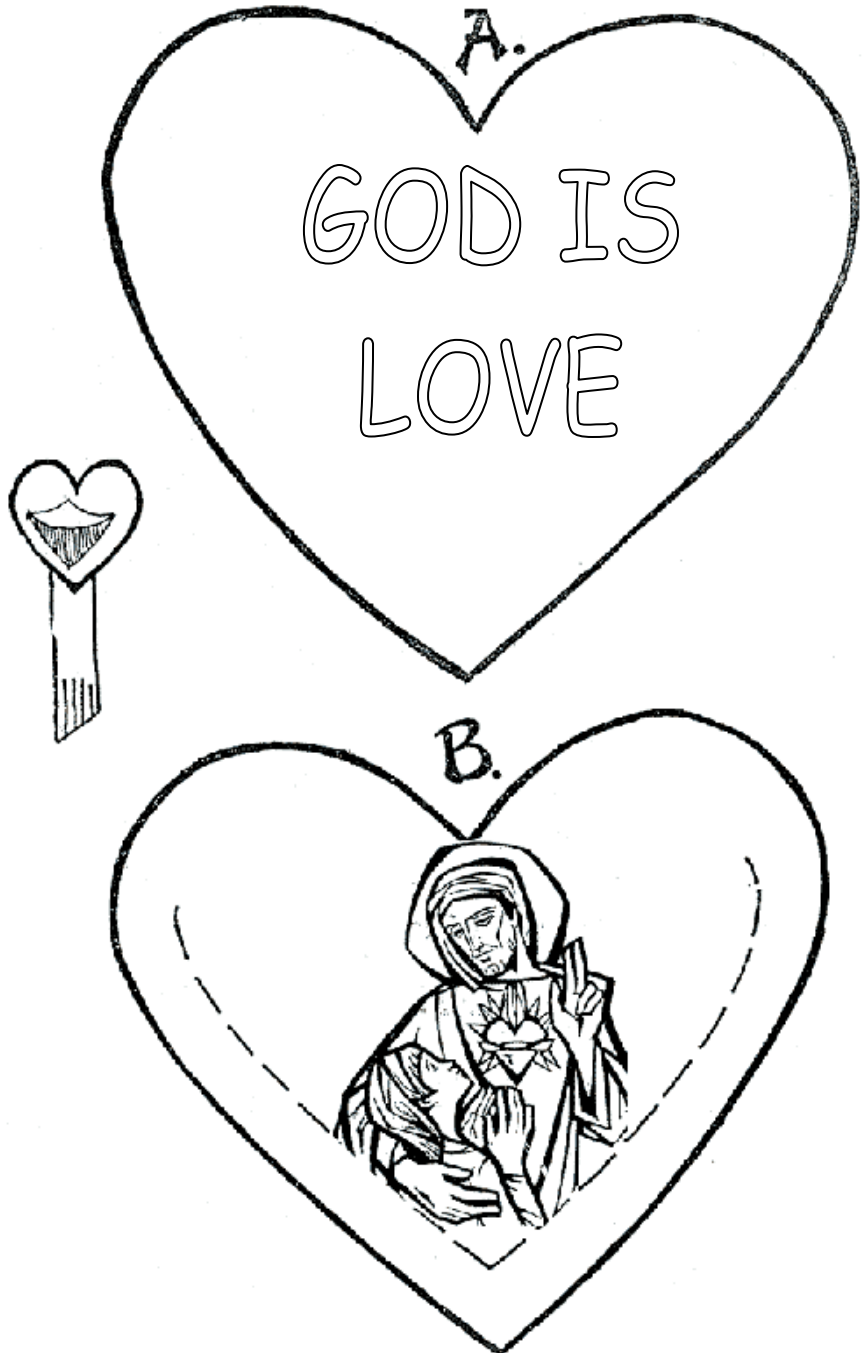
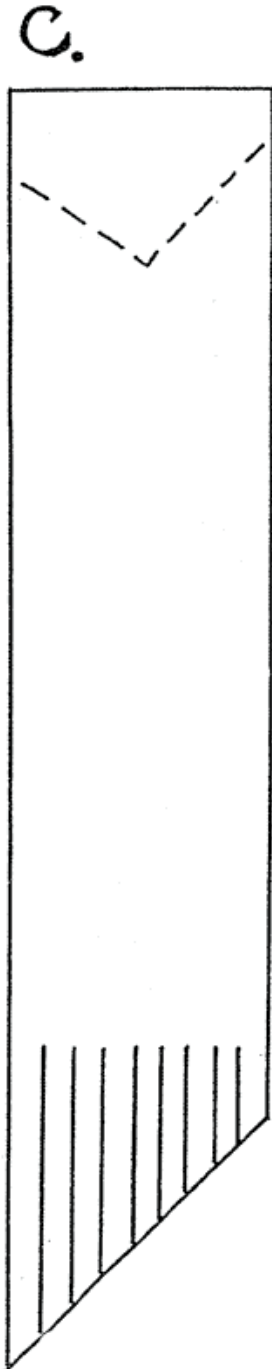

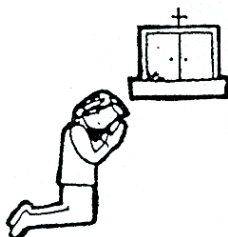

“MARY QUEEN OF PEACE”

(On the 25th anniversary of the apparitions)
MEDJUGORJE June 25—1981—2006

Since the 24 of June 1981, six youngsters from Medjugorje say they see the blessed Virgin Mary. Three of them still continue to have daily apparitions.

In Medjugorje Our Lady appears as “Mary Queen of Peace” in order to obtain peace. The Gospa comes to remind the man of today the gospel message” Faith, conversion sacramental life, the word of God, prayer, sacrifice, simplicity of life.

The messages of the Queen of Peace follow the liturgical calendar. (Advent, Christmas, Easter, Pentecost). Other messages refer to the daily life of our society.

The teaching methods of Our Lady are the same as a mother to her children: patience, love, gentle correction, a great tenderness together with an urgent call to holiness.

Messages of the Blessed Virgin Mary:

“Daily prayer of the holy rosary pray together ... husband, wife, and small children at a designated time in your home (a pause from problems and obligations)”

(August 14, 84)

“Today I call you to renew prayer in your families. Dear children encourage the very young to prayer and attendance to holy Mass”

(March 7, 85)

“Dear children! Today I ask you to read the bible in your bible in your homes every day. Place it in a visible place there, where it always remind you to read it and to pray.”

(October 10, 84)

“Pray for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on your families and on your parish. Pray, and you shall not regret it. God will give you gifts by which you will glorify Him until the end of your life in this earth”

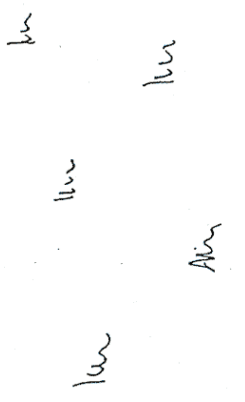
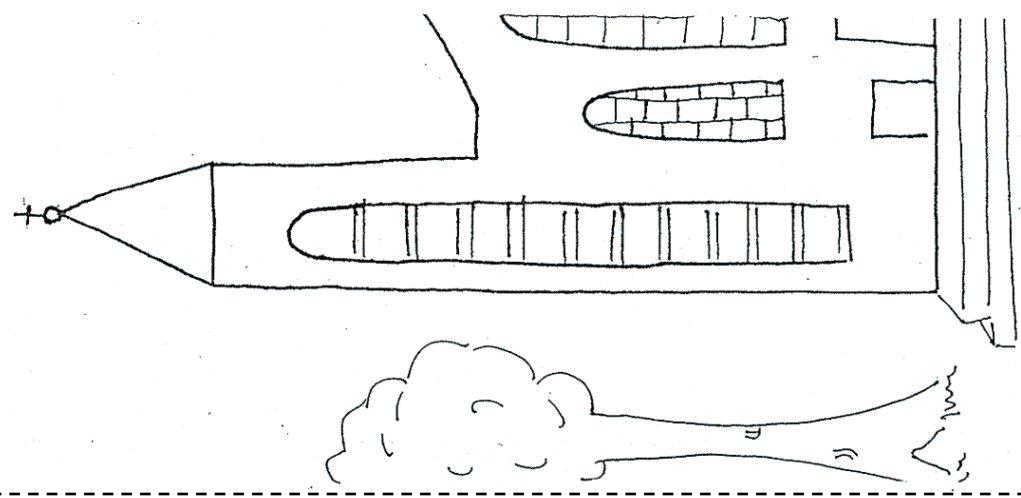
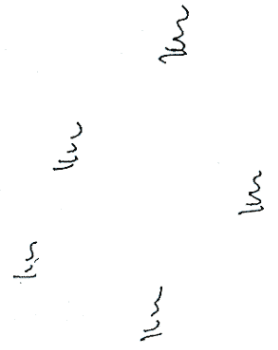
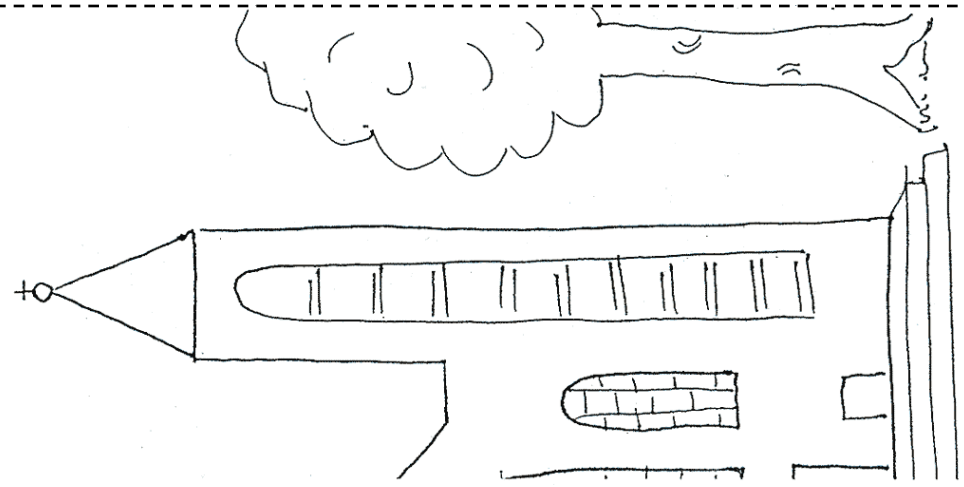

Draw a picture of yourself as you are doing something for someone and being like Jesus, a light in the world. For example: carrying something for someone, smiling, giving a hug to your mom, giving a gift, playing with your little sister or brother, cleaning your room.

Let all members read one or two of their hearts as mini-prayers. After each person's reading, answer out loud: "JESUS, HELP US TO WITH OUR HEART". Begin and end your special prayer with the sing of the cross.



GAMES RULES

It can be play y five players.

Four will move the chip and the fifth one will ask the questions.

This is not a competition game is a game of cooperation. The object of the game is that the four players get to learn the Seven Gifts of The Holy Spirit.

Each one of them will begin by one of the four starting points. Will throw the dice and can advance by the left or right according to what the player choose; until they reach the bug flames at the center , which are the Gifts of the Holy Spirit.

When one of the players rich any of this big flames, which are assigned with a different letter, the player which is asking the questions, will ask the other players a question and they have to guess what gift it is referring.

If they got it right, the flame will go over the flame of which it is refers. If they get it wrong the player who has reach the big flame will go back to the starting point.

The game will end when the four players get a place the seven flames with the answer on top. When they reach the small flames they said this short prayer: "Come Holy Host to my heart!" And move to the next small flame.

When a player falls to one of the letters that says Holy Spirit, and are divided, a question is ask to him or her. If it is right throws the dice again. If does not know it another player can answer. If it is answer right will continuing playing if not will loose a turn.
