13 "LETTERS BY ST. PAUL"



Written to the churches and individuals before the Gospels, 20 to 30 years after the death of Christ. They are the first Christian writings. Doubt exists as to the author of some letters.

Letter to the Romans

- ♥ From Corinth to the Roman Church.
- ♥ Prepare the church for his visit.
- **♥** Written before his final visit to Jerusalem.
- ◆ Explains his point of view after the conflict with the Jewish Christians from Jerusalem.



First letter to the Corinthians

 Advise to the Corinthians about insubordination, chastity and marriage. 8

Second letter to the Corinthians

- ◆ One of Paul's most emotional and sincere letters.
- ♥ He speaks with severity and energy.



Letter to the Galatians

 Admonishes the Galatians who were starting to observe again the strict Jewish laws.



Letter to the Ephesians

- ♥ Letter to a city in Asia Minor.
- ♥ Discusses the role of the Church.

Letter to the Philippians

- ♥ Written when Paul was prisoner in Rome.
- Giving thanks for sending to help

12

Letter to the Colossians

♥ Responding to the advice on theological problems.

13

First letters to the Thessalonians

- Written from Corinth during Paul's first visit.
- Praises the Thessalonians for the good report timothy brought him.

14

second letter to Thessalonians

- ♥ A continuation of the first.
- Paul is worried about their expectation of Jesus' second coming being immediate.

15

First letter to Timothy

- ▶ After Paul is freed from first incarceration in Rome.
- Advises Timothy on how to deal with erroneous ideas of some of the Ephesians.

16

Second letter to Timothy

- ♥ From Rome when Paul was incarcerated for the second time.
- Askş him to come and bring Mark before he is executed.
- ♥ Expresses his deep love for Timothy.

17

Letter to Titus

- Written before the letters to Timothy.
- ♥ Advises collaborators on how to handle the situation in Crete.

18

Letter to Philemon

- Regarding fugitive slave that converted as a result of Paul's preaching.
- Paul asks the owner, Philemon to be merciful and apply the law of Christian law.



Letters to the Hebrews

- ⋆ Author unknown.
- ▼ Style differs from Paul's
- Tries to give enthusiasm to those who await Christ's return persecution. And advises obedience.

Letter from James

- Probably written by a family member of Jesus which later became head of the church in Jerusalem around 62AD.
- Advises followers around the world.

First letter of Peter

- From Rome to the Christian churches in Asia Minor.
- ▼ Encouraging them to confront Increased persecution.

Second letter of Peter

- Exhorts believers to be faithful and without fault.
- Help have hope and faith for the second coming.
- ⋆ Advise against false prophets.




The letter from Jude

 Mysterious symbolism of what will happen with the coming of the reign of god.



Do you listen to God when He whispers in your heart, or do you suffocate his voice and do your own will? Pray for obedience to God's will.




