# MARY, MOTHER OF GOD, JANUARY 1



**On January 1, New Year's Day, we celebrate the Feast of Mary, the Mother of God. This is a special feast and Holy Day of Obligation. At Mass that day, the priest will wear a white vestment in honor of Mary.**

**Jesus is the Prince of Peace; Mary, His Mother, is Our Lady, Queen of Peace. During the Mass on this Feast Day, we pray for peace. Think of the times you have needed God's help to be peace-maker.**



# Through Mary, we receive peace

January 1:

**Talk about the story.** Speak with the children about the year that just ended and the one starting. What would they like to change? What do they wish would happen? Speak about their names. Do they know why they gave them those names? Remind them that, through Baptism, they are children of God. Tell them also that Jesus gave Mary, his mother, to us as our mother.

**Activities.** Let the children write their names in big cards. Mix the cards up and give them to the children. Each child can write a blessing for the child whose name her or she has gotten. Have them tell the names aloud and read the blessing they have written

**You are there.** Imagine you are one of the shepherds. What do you think is going on when you see the light and listen to the angels? What do you take to the child? What does Mary tell you?



## Jesus, your friend, invites you:

- ☞ At the beginning of this year, Jesus invites us to think about how we use our time: how we try to do our best.
- ☞ Mary thought about Jesus' things and rejoiced. Do I speak to Jesus and ask him for help to do things well?

# Three wise men follow a star

January 7:  
Epiphany

Isa. 60:1-6;  
Eph 3:5-6;  
Matthew 2:1-12

**Talk about the story.** Speak with the children about looking for something. How do they finally find what they want? Is there something so important for them that they would risk many things to look for it? What do they think the Magi might have been looking for? Why was that so important for them? What are the best gift they received this Christmas? What would they like to offer Jesus?

**Activities.** Bring to class a box full of gifts. Ask the children to choose one that symbolizes what they to do this week. They can write the offering on a card and place it in the box together with their gift to be presented at the Offertory.

**You are there.** What difficulties do you find on the journey? Do you think that at times the travelers must have been lost? What do you think about Herod?

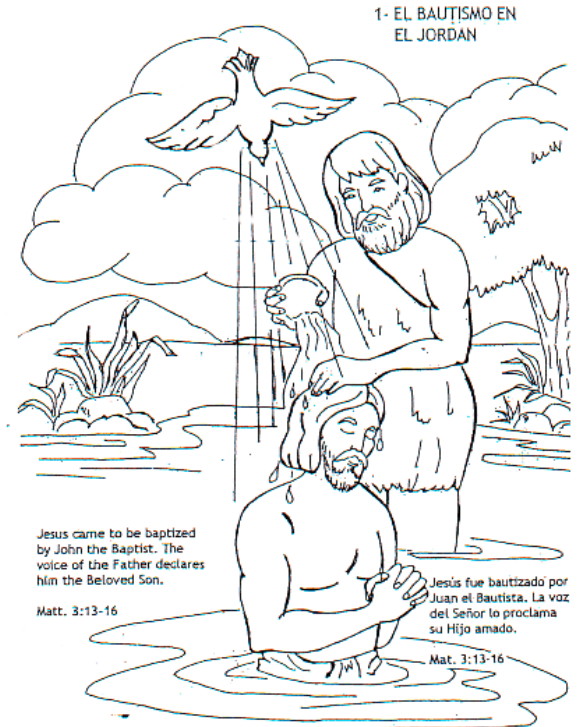

**Talk about the story.** Speak with the children about the meaning of caring for a person, or feeling cared for. Who takes care of them? How do they feel when they are with someone they know will take care of them? Do they feel proud of their last name and of their parents? How much more would it be to feel as children of God himself? What do they know about their Baptism? Why did they get their names?

**Activities.** Bring business cards to class as a model and ask the children to make their own. Under their name, they can write "position" (e.i. son, daughter of God)

**You are there.** What do you think about John? Do you think he is being too humble saying that someone greater than him was coming? Don't you think John would have a right to be honored since he was there first? Are you scared when you hear the voice from heaven? Do you hear God day of you that you, too, are a beloved child of God?



### Jesus, your friend, invites you:

☞ Jesus is going to start the task of announcing to all that God loves them very much. He invites you to go with him. How can you show others that God is good and loves them?

### What am I going to do?

Speak to Jesus and tell him how you want to show that God loves us, by being kind toward all. Tell him what you would like to do:

☺ For example: I will thank God for calling me to be his child through my Baptism.



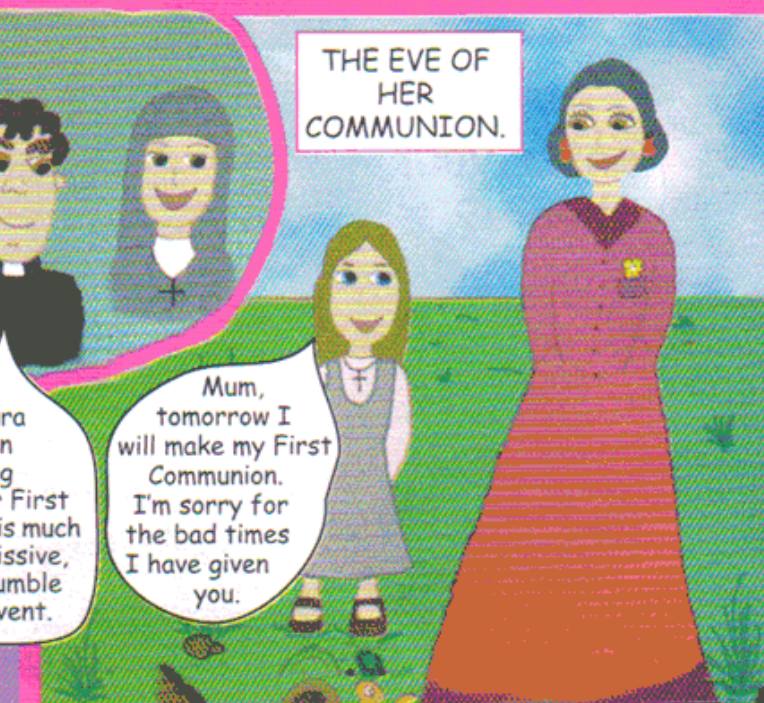
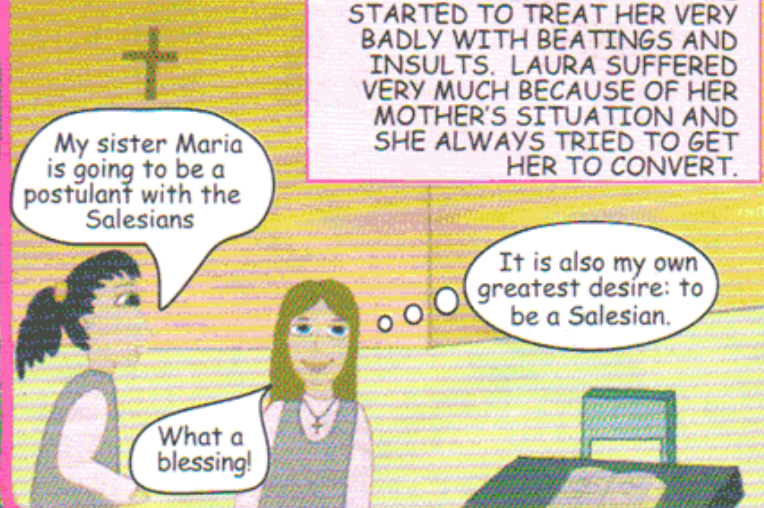
LAURA AND JULIA ENTERED THE COLLEGE RUN BY THE SALESIANS.

# St. Thomas Aquinas

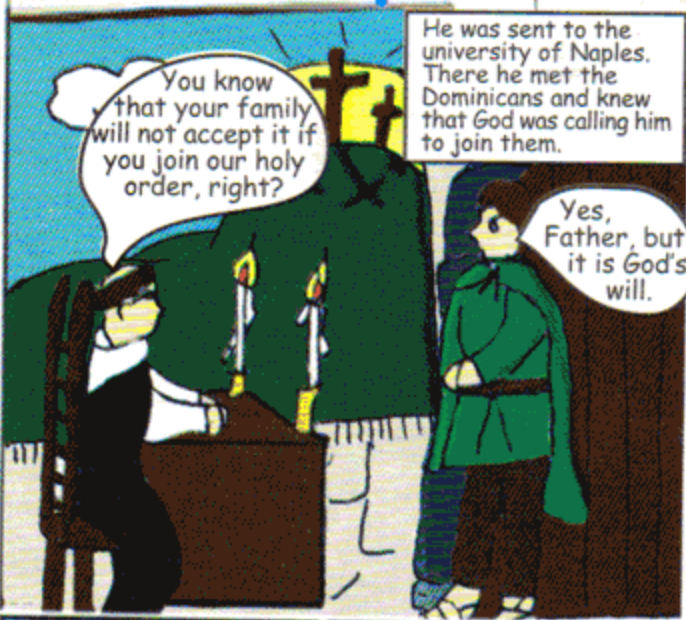

What is God?

St. Thomas Aquinas was born at the end of the 13th century. At five years of age, he was sent to live and study with Benedictine monks. He was always asking questions.



You know that your family will not accept it if you join our holy order, right?

He was sent to the university of Naples. There he met the Dominicans and knew that God was calling him to join them.

Yes, Father, but it is God's will.

Thomas' family was furious when they found out what he had done.



The Dominicans actually beg for their food. It is a disgrace to our family name!

I know, my son, we must fetch him back!

Thomas' superiors decided to send him to Paris, where he would be safer. The Countess of Aquinas sent her two oldest sons to capture him.



There he is! Let's get him!

God, protect me.

They locked him up in a family castle. He refused to give up his vocation. His brothers even tore his habit off of him. His sisters, however, snuck a new one in to him.



Lord, I trust this is your will. Help me remain firm!

He spent his time praying and reading.

Thomas' sisters knew that God wanted him to be a Dominican. They came up with a plan of escape.



My time of trial has come to an end! I may now continue serving Our Lord as a Dominican.



Back with his fellow brothers, Thomas was sent to study under Albert the Great. Everyone thought that he was stupid because he never said anything in class.

Dumb ox!  
I bet he can't even write his own name!

In reality, he kept silent in order to remain humble.



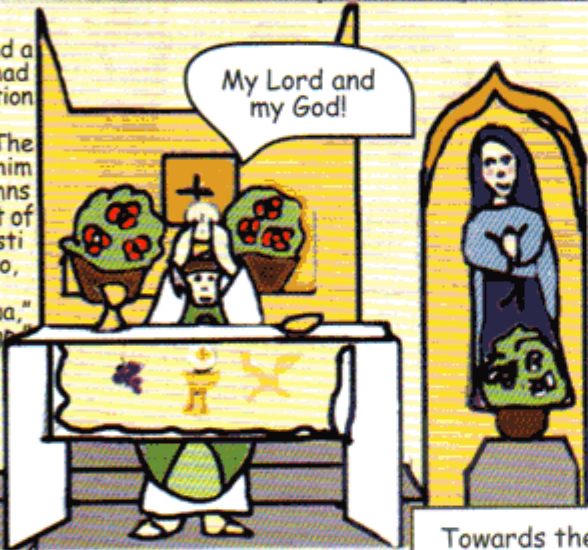
However, St. Albert recognized Thomas' God-given intelligence.

You call him the dumb-ox! I tell you, one day, his bellowing will resound throughout the whole world!



Thomas was soon ordained a priest. He had a great devotion to the Eucharist. The Pope asked him to write hymns for the feast of Corpus Christi and he did so, composing "Pange Lingua," "Tantum ergo" and many others.

St. Thomas wrote many books about the Faith. One of the most famous is the Summa Theologica. He is called the Angelic Doctor because of all that he wrote for the Church

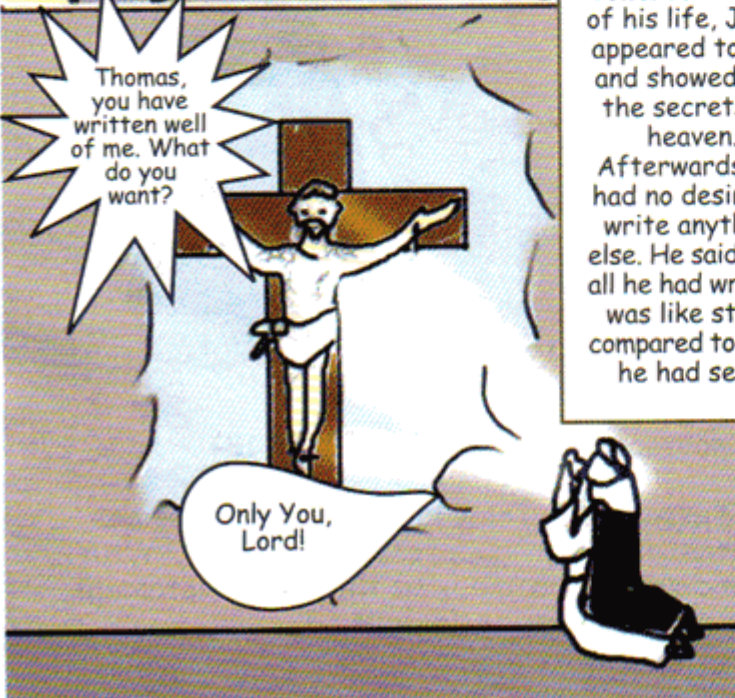


Towards the end of his life, Jesus appeared to him and showed him the secrets of heaven. Afterwards, he had no desire to write anything else. He said that all he had written was like straw compared to what he had seen.

Soon afterwards, St. Thomas died. He was about 50 years old. This had been his only desire for the last years of his life.

**Talk about the story.** Speak with the children about parties. Which are the most joyful ones? What makes them so? Have they ever been to a party that was almost ruined? What was lacking? What gives them great joy? What qualities do they have that they can use to make others happy (kindness, wit, humor, intelligence, singing)?

**Activities.** Draw and cut out six great jars. Name those jars with the "wine" of some good action they can do to make others happy (generosity, kindness, sharing, helping, humor, music).

**You are there.**

Imagine you are one of the servants. Do you think it is silly to fill the jars with water? What do you think when you realize it is wine?

**Jesus, your friend, invites you:**

- 📖 Jesus thought it wasn't his time yet, but he listened to his mom who felt sorry of the bride and groom. Do you sometimes think of how you could help to solve someone else's problem?

# They nearly killed Jesus

Jr. 1:4-5, 17-19;

Lucas 4:21-30

## Talk about the story.

Talk with the children about the nicknames given to classmates who behave or study a lot. Have they ever been afraid of being called those names or being excluded from a group? Have they ever been approached by older kids to take drugs or join a gang? Do they ever do things just because everyone else does them? Have they ever felt embarrassed if others thought they were kind, helpful, or patient? Do they think the power that protected Jesus could be with them, too?

## Activities.

Read the passage from the First Letter to the Corinthians and ask the children to choose one of the characteristics of love (patient, support, forgiveness) and make a drawing depicting these qualities. They should present their drawings at the Offertory or to their families at home.

**Final prayer.** As each child presents a drawing the class should ask for the strength to love like that. All answer: "Jesus, you teach us to love".

## You are there.

Would you try to protect Jesus from the crowd or would you be scared that they might want to kill you, too?

Do you think Jesus was scared of falling down the cliff?

Who do you think was protecting him?

## Jesus, your friend, invites you:

- ☞ In the first reading we meet Jeremiah, a young person sent to tell people what god want of them.
- ☞ Jeremiah is afraid of being rejected and laughed at, but God promises him protection.
- ☞ When you know have to do something well, are you afraid of people will say?

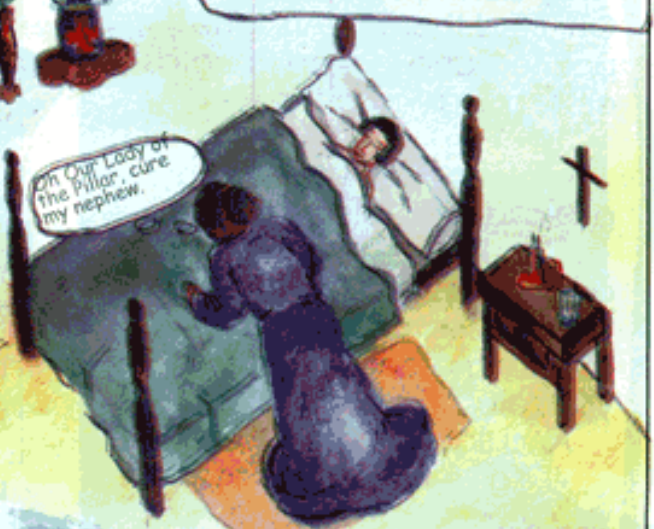


Son, what joy you would give me if you were to become a priest!

HENRY RECOVERS AND RETURNS TO VINEBRE. HIS FATHER, DETERMINED TO MAKE A BUSINESSMAN OUT OF HIM, SENDS HIM TO REUS. THERE HE READS THE LIFE OF ST. THERESA, WHICH WILL INFLUENCE HIM SO MUCH.

HIS BROTHER GOES TO FIND HIM AND BRINGS HIM BACK HOME HIS FATHER EVENTUALLY GIVES HIM PERMISSION TO GO TO THE SEMINARY



I am a son of the Church!

HE IS ORDAINED A PRIEST ON THE 21-IX-1867.

Come on, children, we have to win souls for Christ



THE REVOLUTION, IN WHICH THE CHURCH IS PERSECUTED, BREAKS OUT IN 1868. ST. HENRY FIGHTS AGAINST IT WITH MANY PUBLICATIONS.

With your prayer and example you must help to save souls.



IN 1876 HE FOUNDS THE LITTLE COMPANY OF THE CHILD JESUS.

Look at what Fr. Henry has written

St. Theresa used to say: "Give me a quarter of an hour of prayer and I will give you Heaven"

The quarter of an hour of prayer!



YIPPEE! I'll do it.

CONCERNED ABOUT THE DANGERS THAT THREATEN THE FAITH OF THE YOUNG PEOPLE, HE FOUNDS THE CONGREGATION OF THE MOST PURE CONCEPTION (for girls) AND THE BROTHERHOOD OF ST. JOSEPH (for boys). BUT HIS GREATEST WORK WAS THE FOUNDATION OF THE COMPANY OF ST. THERESA.

Daughters, live the spirit of St. Theresa



We will be apostles of women with prayer, teaching and sacrifice.

AT THE END OF HIS LIFE HE SUFFERED VERY MUCH, ESPECIALLY BECAUSE OF THE DIVISION OF THE COMPANY. HE DIED SUDDENLY IN VALENCIA, IN THE CONVENT OF GILEL ON THE 27th OF JANUARY 1896.

WE CELEBRATE HIS FEAST-DAY ON THE 27th OF JANUARY
