June 3rd:
The Most Holy Trinity

Prov. 8:23-31;
Rom. 5:1-5;
John 16:12-15

Talk about the story. Talk with the children about the people they love. How do they relate to them? Can they tell them all their secrets? Do they sometimes feel as if they wanted to be “inside” the other person, or that they guess what he or she is thinking? Is there any person with whom they would like to have that sort of unity, but there is something hindering it? How do they feel about it?



Q: Before we go to bed, we make the sign of the cross and pray. When we do, we express our faith in God and God’s love for us. Do you thank God for your loved ones when you pray at night? Who do you pray for?

Activities and prayer. Place a container with water and three candles on a table and ask the children to come one by one and hold the three candles together so that they have just one flame. Each child can make a brief prayer for his or her family, friends, and community. All answer: “We believe in God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit

You are there.

What would you like to ask Jesus about being one with the Father and the Holy Spirit.

Jesus, your friend, invites you:

📖 When you love someone very much, sometimes it seems as if you think the same things and can read each other’s mind. That is the way Jesus would like you to love him and everyone around you, because that’s the way Jesus loves you.

What am I going to do?

Speak to Jesus and tell him about the people you really love. Tell him you also want to love him that much. If you are angry at someone, ask Jesus to help you to make up with that person. Tell him what you would like to do this week:

☺ For example: I will tell someone in my family how much I love him or her.

☺ For example: I will make up with someone with whom I am angry.

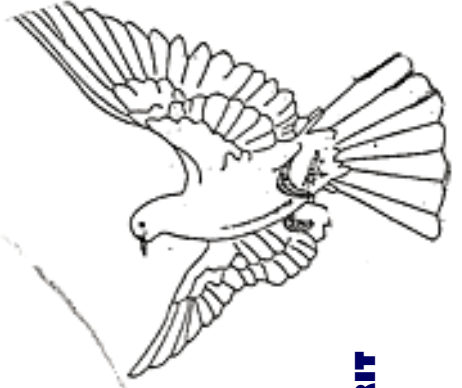

Talk about the story. Speak with the children about things they like to eat. Do they give thanks for the food and for those who prepare it? Do they complain when there is something they don't like? Have they heard the expression, "she/he is better than bread"? Do they know people who are very good? Has it ever seemed as if there wasn't enough food in their home and then they had more than enough?

Activities. Cut out loaves. On the back of each loaf, the children can write something they would like to share (talent, time, some material thing). All the loaves are placed in a basket and thanks God for what has been given to him or her.

Final Prayer. Each child thanks God for what they have received. All answer: "They can then make a Corpus Christi procession. (If the priest can come they can explain the tradition of processions and use the monstrance)"

You are there.

Can you imagine the food endlessly coming out of the baskets? How would you feel? Did you eat as much as you wanted? What do you think Jesus was trying to tell us with this miracle?



Q: Sometimes we wish for things we do not have, but are not always thankful for the good things we already have. Do you thank Jesus for your family and friends? What else should you thank him for?

Jesus, your friend, invites you:

☞ Sometimes we think we don't have enough belonging, and we complain. But Jesus teaches us to give thanks for what we do have. If we shared what we have, everyone would have enough. Are you grateful for what you have? Do you share with others? Jesus gives himself in the Eucharist. What can you give?

What am I going to do?

Speak to Jesus and tell him what you are hungry for –what things you would like to have. Thank him for what you already have (the love of some member of your family, your good qualities, your friends, and so on). Tell him what you would like to do this week:

- ☺ For example: I will give thanks for the good things in life
- ☺ For example: I will share what I have with my classmates or brothers and sisters.

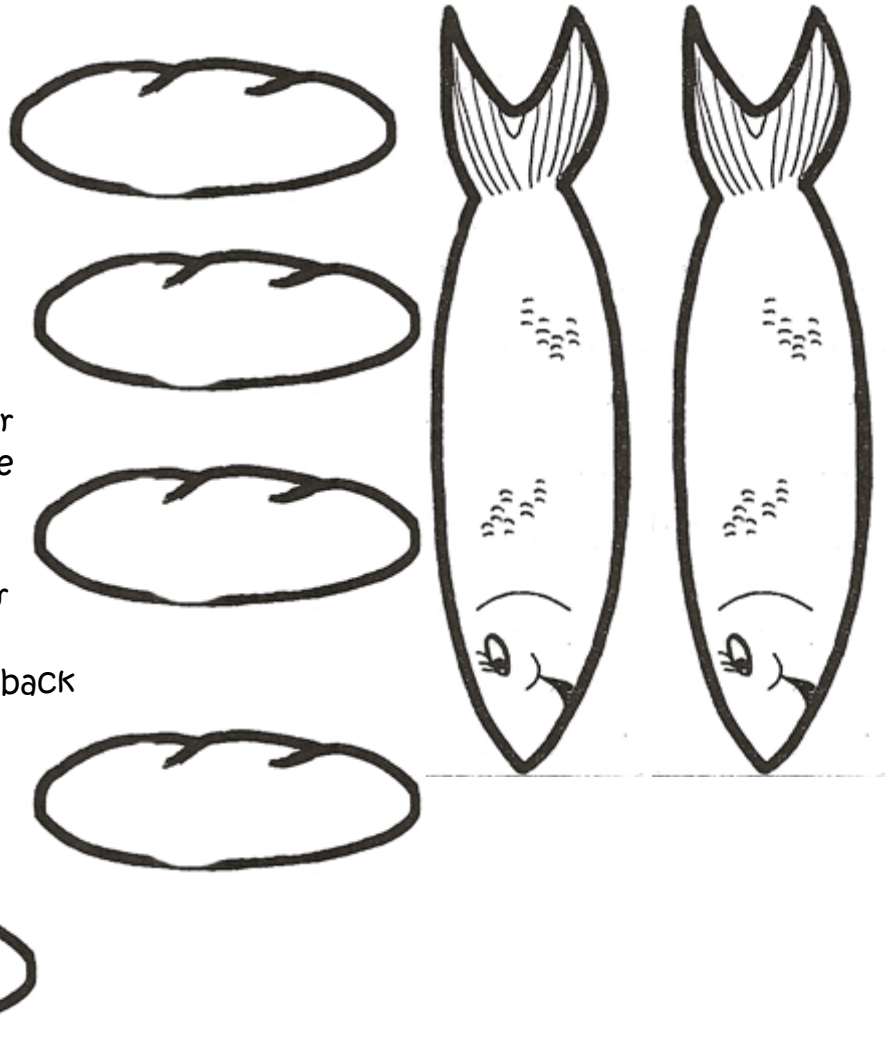

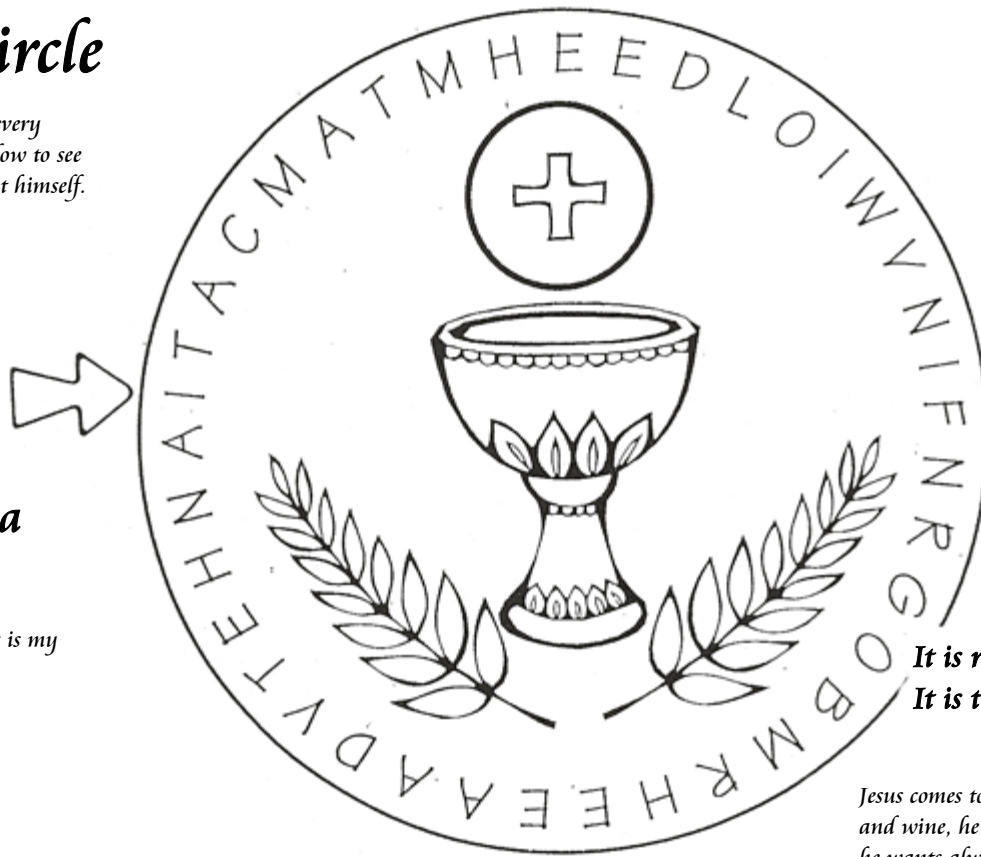

Beginning at the arrow copy every other letter onto the blanks below to see that Jesus told the people about himself.



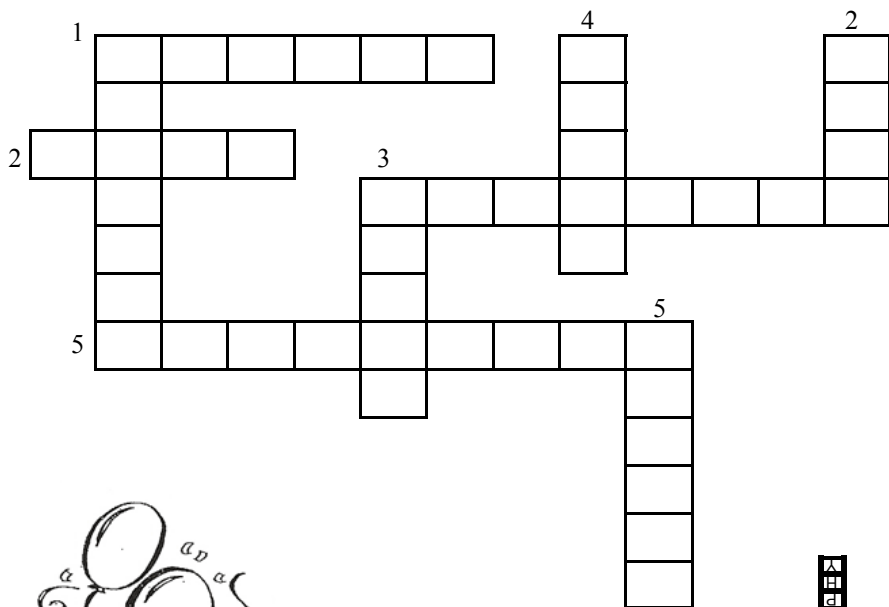

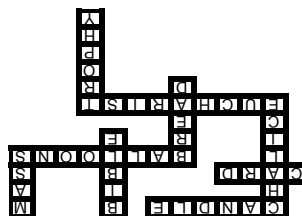

The Eucharist

Miracle, Saint Clare of Assisi, Year 1240

St. Clare of Assisi: An army of Saracens, who did not like God, came to Assisi one day. They planned to destroy the city and enter the Convent where St. Clare and her Sisters lived! Everyone was afraid of these men. St. Clare knew that Jesus was with them in The Holy Eucharist, and that He could protect them. So, she took Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and carried Him outside to the city walls. Her Sister joined her in heartfelt prayer to Jesus, pleading for His help. When the men saw St. Clare with Jesus in the Holy Eucharist they run away in fear! Not long before St. Clare died she longed to go to Midnight Mass with her Sisters, but she was too sick to even get out of bed. During the Mass, miraculously, Jesus made it possible for St. Clare to be carried through the air to the Basilica! Then she was taken to the cave where Jesus was born in Bethlehem 1200 years before. She saw the Baby Jesus with Mary, Joseph and the animals.



Sacred Heart

Talk about the story. Speak with the children about some time when they felt forgiven for something they thought was too bad. How did they feel? Did they react being more affectionate toward the person who forgave them? Have they ever forgiven someone and have realized that afterwards they had become closer friends?



Activities. Ask the children to write up a bill including all the good things they have received from family members or friends. In the payable column they can write things they will do to show that gratitude.

Final Prayer. Name persons who have done something good for us or have forgiven us. All say: "Jesus, your forgiveness is abundant and generous".

You are there.

Are you more surprised at the attitude of the woman, or that of the guests? What side do you think you be on?

Q: Jesus did not turn away the woman who had not led a very good life even when others doubted her. Jesus saw her love and told her that her sins had been forgiven. Would you like Jesus to forgive you for something?

Jesus, your friend, invites you:

- ☞ Jesus says that, when you have received much love, the normal things is to respond with a lot of love. How do you respond when someone treats you with affection?
- ☞ Jesus feel pity for this woman and, with love, leads her to the right way.
- ☞ How do you feel when someone forgives you for something you had done wrong?

What am I going to do?

Speak to Jesus and tell him how you feel when you have done something wrong and then you are forgiven with affection. Tell him what you want to do :

- ☺ For example: I will in turn forgive a sibling or classmate who has hurt me.
- ☺ For example: I will not criticize when I see that my mom or dad forgive one of my siblings for something he or she has done wrong.

Talk about the story. Talk with the children about the people for whom they are important. Has their mom told them sometimes how she prepared for their birth? Why did they give them the name they carry? Why are names important? Speak about how John had a mission even before he was born. Do they have some mission, something they know they must do? What would they like to do when they grow up?

Activities and prayer. Dramatize the scene of John's presentation to the people, adding: "John, you will ..." Give our papers where the children can write missions (good things that each child can do). Ask the children to send their paper to another kid telling him what they can do (make others happy, behave in class, help at home ...) Carry the papers in a basket at the Offertory procession.

You are there.

Are you scared when you hear Zechariah speak?
Do you thank him for being so good to you.



Q: After his son was born, Zechariah could suddenly speak. Why was he able to speak after being quiet for so long?

Jesus, your friend, invites you:

- God chose John before he was born. Do you think God might also have chosen you to do his work?
- Do you thank him for being so good to you?

What am I going to do?

Speak to Jesus and tell him about people for whom you are important. Thank Jesus because you know you are important for him. Tell him what you want to do:

- ☺ For example: When I have to do something difficult, I will ask Jesus for help
- ☺ For example: I will listen to the adults and be grateful for all they have done for me.

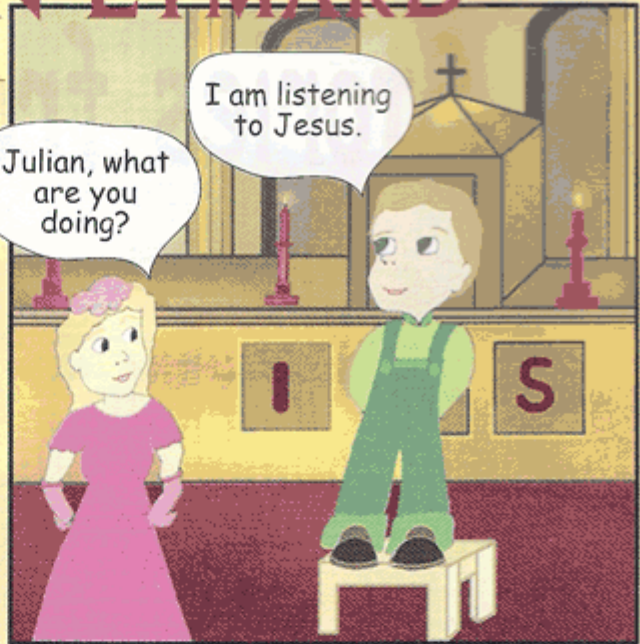

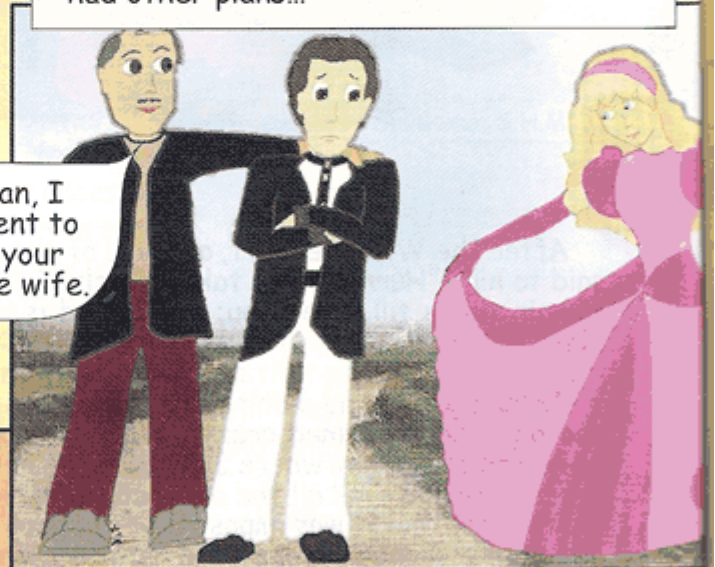

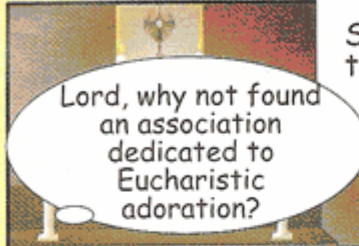


For many years, his father did

He was finally ordained priest, and entered into a religious order, called the Marists. In his parishes, Julian made the Eucharist known, loved and adored.

Seventeen years later, praying before the Blessed Sacrament, he received an inspiration.

With the permission of his superiors, he left the congregation and founded three branches...

Of course you can. Jesus has redeemed us all by His cross."

The feminine branch of the Servants of the Most Blessed Sacrament was dedicated to adoration and the evangelization of the youth.



Fulfill your Christian duty before God and make the Eucharist the center of your lives."

Julian said to the lay people:

And the masculine branch of the Servants of the Most Blessed Sacrament had the most sacred mission of all...



In his last sermon, he exclaimed:
