The month of mary

Traditionally, May is set aside by the Church to honor Mary. Typically, public devotions including the Rosary, a litany, or May crownings are scheduled in parishes during this month. We honor Mary as the Mother of the Son of God, as the first Christian, and as our Mother.

In following God's plan for her to become the Mother of Jesus, Mary accepted God's will and exhibited her deep faith in God. Having a new baby is exciting, but it is also a tremendous responsibility. We can only imagine how Mary might have felt when told that her Son was the Son of God.

During the month of May, your family can focus on Mary by saying a decade of the Rosary each day. Use the joyful mysteries: the Annunciation, the Visitation, the Nativity, the Presentation, and the Finding of the Child Jesus in the Temple. Each of these events is related in the Gospel of Luke. Ask a member of the family to read one of the events, then ask the family to meditate on the event while reciting the ten Hail Marys of the Rosary. Use the chart below to help you plan your May devotions to Mary.



ST. JOSEPH THE WORKER

MAY 1



This is St. Joseph's second feast day on the Church calendar of celebrations. We honor him also on March 19. St. Joseph is very important saint. He is the husband of Our Lady and the foster-father of Jesus.

Today we celebrate his witness of hard work. He was carpenter who worked long hours in his little shop. St. Joseph teaches us that the work we do is important. Through it we give our contribution and our services to our family and society. But even more than that. As Christians we realize that our work is like a mirror of ourselves. That is why we want our work to be done with diligence.

Many countries set aside one day a year to honor workers. This encourages the dignity and appreciation of work. The Church has given us a wonderful model of work, St. Joseph. In 1955, Pope Pius XII proclaimed this feast of St. Joseph the Worker to be celebrated every year.

We can ask St. Joseph to help us become more diligent in our study and work:

Saint Joseph, husband of Mary, you were always aware of God's presence. Help me find God in my life, and be with me at the hour of my death. Catechesis H.M. No. 19

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

Jesus the real vine

"I am the real vine, and my Father is the gardener. He breaks off every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and he prunes every branch that does bear fruit, so that it will be clean and bear more fruit. You have been made clean already by the teaching I have given you. Remain united to me, and I will remain united to you. A branch cannot bear fruit by itself; it can do so only if it remains in the vine. In the same way you cannot bear fruit unless you remain in me. "I am the vine, and you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will bear much fruit; for you can do nothing without me. Those who do not remain in me are thrown out like a branch and dry up; such branches are gathered up and thrown into the fire, where they are burned. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, then you will ask for anything you wish, and you shall have it. My Father's glory is shown by your bearing much fruit; and in this way you become my disciples. (John 15: 1-8)


Reflection

In the readings or this week we find this message: a) with trust in God's protection, the church finds peace and continues to grow and flourish. b) The authenticity of love must be demonstrated in concrete actions. c) Christ depends on us to be his hands and the voice to bring salvation to others. What happens to the branches if they are torn from the trunk and are no replanted? By itself it will die. Whom do they need? Be united to the branch in the same way we need to be unite to Jesus to grow. What does being very close to another person mean? To whom do they feel united? What does "giving fruit" mean? What good fruits can they give? Do they think that giving fruit means earning lots of fame and money?

Prayer

Sometimes, Lord we get separated from you, or we forget your presence. And then it seems life ceases to have meaning and joy. Remind us always that, in order to live and give fruit, we need to be united among ourselves and with you like the vine. Amen






Activity

6th Sunday of Easter May 13, 2012 Readings: Acts 10: 25-26, 34-35, 44-48 ;Psalm 97 ;1John 4:7-10 ;John 15: 9-17

I love you just as the Father loves me; remain in my love. If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in his love.

I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. My commandment is this: love one another, just as I love you. The greatest love you can have for your friends is to give your life for them. And you are my friends if you do what I command you. I do not call you servants any longer, because servants do not know what their master is doing. Instead, I call you friends, because I have told you everything I heard from my father. You did not choose me; I chose you and appointed you to go and bear much fruit, the kind of fruit that endures. And so the Father will give you whatever you ask of him in my name. This, then, is what I command you: love one another. (John 15: 9-17)

Reflection

Make a list of the persons that love you. What do those people do for them? What would they do for them? What are you willing to sacrifice for the people you love? Jesus gave His life for us. How can we thank Jesus for what He did for us? Give enough time to share.

Activity

Prepare a poster board with a big picture of Jesus. Cut one heart for each child. Ask them to write on them their name and name of the person that loves them on front. In the back they can write what they would do for them this week. Each child paste the heart on the poster. Before the group ends they pick up their heart to take to the special person? You have a model on the next page.

Prayer

We use the word love frequently, Lord, but sometimes we don't think about how much it demands from us. It demanded your own life. Look with mercy, Lord, on the sacrifices we make for our families and friends. Give us courage to give of ourselves to others and to bring your message everywhere. Amen

Ascension of the Lord- May 20, 2012 Readings: Acts 1:1-11 Psalm 46 Eph 4: 1-13 Mark 16:15-20

He said to them, "Go throughout the whole world and preach the gospel to all people. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved; whoever does not believe will be condemned. Believers will be given the power to perform miracles: they will drive out demons in my name; they will speak in strange tongues; if they pick up snakes or drink any poison, they will not be harmed; they will place their hands on sick people, and these will get well."

After the Lord Jesus had talked with them, he was taken up to heaven and sat at the right side of God. The disciples went and preached everywhere, and the Lord worked with them and proved that their preaching was true by the miracles that were performed.

Reflection

Jesus has shown a great love and now He wants his friends to help him in the mission to tell others how good God is, not only with words but with actions. How can you help Jesus to proclaim the Good News?

Activity


Prepare a small box to place some white index cards in it. In each card write a message from Jesus for each children (The mission God ask them to do). Example:

Pentecost May 27, 2012 Readings: Acts 2: 1-11; Psalm 103; 1Corinthians 12, 36 -7.12-13 John 20, 19-23

Jesus Appears to His Disciples

It was late that Sunday evening, and the disciples were gathered together behind locked doors, because they were afraid of the Jewish authorities. Then Jesus came and stood among them. "Peace be with you," he said. After saying this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples were filled with joy at seeing the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father sent me, so I send you. "Then he breathed on them and said, Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive people's sins, they are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven."

Reflection

The readings of this week give us the message that The Spirit of God cast out fear and turns the disciples into proclaimers of the Resurrection of Jesus.

Explain us the gifts and talents of each other are different, but all of us are called to serve God. Jesus gives the Spirit to the disciples and sends them out to proclaim his word and forgive sins. In which ways is the Spirit of God present in us? In their families?

Activity

Act the first reading with the children.(Acts 2,1-11 Prepare tongues, one for each. Write on them the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Form them in a circle and begin to pray. Place one in each children head, at time the wind blows. Pray over them asking for the gift he or she has receive. All hold hands in a circle and pray together.

Prayer



"Drive Winds and Tongues of Flame, these are the ways the Holy Spirit came!


On each of the flames is a prayer asking for help to live out one of the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Write the word which
