<p>What we doing on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday when we eat only one full meal and avoid eating between meals?</p> <p>FASTING</p>	<p>What is loving communion with God, in which we talk and listen to God?</p> <p>PRAYER</p>	<p>What is the giving of money or our time or talents or other material things to those who are in need?</p> <p>WORKS OF MERCY</p>	<p>What do we call the suffering and death of Jesus that we hear read from the Gospel of Mark (14:1-15; 15-57), on Palm Sunday and the Gospel of John (18:1-19:42) on Good Friday?</p> <p>THE PASSION</p>
<p>What is a deep and strong change of heart, when we turn away from sin and evil and toward God?</p> <p>CONVERSION</p>	<p>What do we do to show our sorrow for sin and wrongdoing, and to help undo damage that may have been caused by our sin?</p> <p>PENANCE</p>	<p>What do we call the service of Holy Saturday night that consists of the Service of Light, the Liturgy of the Word, Christian Initiation (or renewal of baptism vows), and the Holy Eucharist, celebrating Jesus' Resurrection?</p> <p>PASCUAL VIGIL</p>	<p>What is the liturgical color that symbolizes sorrow and penance during the season of Lent?</p> <p>PURPLE</p>
<p>What day do we celebrate the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, when we remember the Last Supper, during which Jesus gave to us the gift of himself in the Eucharist?</p> <p>HOLY THURSDAY</p>	<p>What is the Good Friday ritual that consists of showing special respect to the wood of the cross?</p> <p>VENERATION OF THE CROSS</p>	<p>What is the first day of Lent?</p> <p>ASH WEDNESDAY</p> <p>What is placed on our forehead in the sign of the cross on the first day of the Lent as a reminder to do penance?</p> <p>HOLY ASHES</p>	<p>What is the devotion that remembers Jesus' path to his crucifixion on Calvary?</p> <p>THE WAY OF THE CROSS</p>
<p>What do we call the three days that are the highest point of the liturgical year, when we commemorate the institution of the Eucharist and the passion, death, and Resurrection of Jesus?</p> <p>PASCUAL TRIDIUM</p>	<p>What day of the Triduum do we remember Jesus' suffering and death?</p> <p>GOOD FRIDAY</p>	<p>What begins on Palm Sunday and is a time during which we remember the last days of Jesus' life?</p> <p>HOLY WEEK</p>	<p>What is the event that is at the core of all Christian beliefs and practices, that proclaims Jesus of Nazareth suffered, died, was buried, and was raised to new life with God?</p> <p>THE RESURRECTION</p>
