It was a custom among the Jews that when a baby boy was a month old he was brought to the Temple and given to the Lord. So Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to Jerusalem.

A good old man named Simeon was led by the Spirit of God to the Temple. He took Jesus into his arms and praised God. "Now, Lord, I am ready to die, for I have seen the promised Child Who is to be the Savior of the world."

Simeon then said to Mary: "Because of your Child, many in Israel will fall and rise, for He will not be received by all. A sword will pierce your own soul."

The Messiah

The great hope of the Jewish people. In that time was the coming of a Messiah promised by God.

"Messiah" means the anointed (in the Old Testament the king, prophets, and priest were anointed as a sign of dedication for a special task).

The Jewish Scriptures were filled with predictions about the Messiah, and many Jews thought the Messiah would be a great ruler, equal to the greatest of their kings, King David.

However the Messiah would also have to be a priest in order to spread the true teaching of God.

Under this King-Priest, peace and justice would rule and would again become a great nation.

It isn't surprising that the people anxiously awaited the arrival of the "Messiah"





The MEANING of this Feast ...

When only forty days old, Jesus was offering Himself to His heavenly Father as a sacrifice for the salvation of the world in the arms of His Mother.

She now offered her Son to God as she would offer Him standing beneath the cross on Calvary.

Our Lady of Lourdes (1844-1879)

Miraculous Vision

If you go to the town of Lourdes in the mountains of southwest France, you will see an incredible sight. Every year, about three million pilgrims visit the grotto and nearby spring there, hoping the waters will cure them of illnesses and disabilities.

The miraculous cures are part of the story of St. Bernadette Soubirous. She was a frail teenager from Lourdes whom the Mother of God appeared at the grotto. "I am the Immaculate Conception", said the vision in white during one of her eighteen appearances.

She told Bernadette where to find the origin of the spring and where to dig in the ground for it. And she asked the girl to go and tell the priest to build a chapel at the grotto and have precessions made to it. Bernadette became a nun, unaware that Lourdes, as well as she herself would change from being virtually unknown to world famous.



No one lights a lamp and puts it under a bowl; instead it is put on the lamp stand, where it gives light for everyone in the house. In the same way your light must shine before people, so that they will see the good things you do and praise your Father in heaven. (Matthew 5, 13-16)

Reflection

The readings of this week let us know that we are called to be salt and light in our daily acts of service, listening and generosity.



Activity



6th Sunday in Ordinary Time, February 13, 2011

Readings: Sirach 15, 16-21; Psalm 118; 1Corinthians 2, 6-10; Matthew 5, 17-37

Teaching about the law

Do not think that I have come to do away with the Law of Moses and the teachings of the prophets. I have not come to do away with them, but to make their teachings come true. Remember that as long as heaven and earth last, not the least point nor the smallest detail of the Law will be done away with not until the end of all things. So then, whoever disobeys even the least important of the commandments and teaches others to do the same, will be least in the Kingdom of heaven. On the other hand, whoever obeys the Law and teaches others to do the same, will be great in the Kingdom of heaven. I tell you, then, that you will be able to enter the Kingdom of heaven only if you are more faithful than the teachers of the law and the Pharisees in doing what God requires. You have heard that people were told in the past, Do not commit murder; anyone who does will be brought to trial. But now I tell you: if you are angry with your brother you will be brought to trial, if you call your brother you- good- for nothing! you will be brought before the Council, and if you call your brother a worthless fool you will be in danger of going to the fire of hell. So if you are about to offer your gift to God at the altar and there you remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar, go at once and make peace with your brother, and then come back and offer your gift to God."If someone brings a lawsuit against you and takes you to court, settle the dispute while there is time before you get to court. Once you are there, you will be turned over to the judge, who will hand you over to the police, and you will be put in jail. There you will stay, I tell you, until you pay the last penny of your fine. "You have heard that it was said, 'Do not commit adultery. But now I tell you: anyone who looks at a woman and wants to possess her is guilty of committing adultery with her in his heart. So if your right eye causes you to sin, take it out and throw it away! It is much better for you to lose a part of your body than to have your whole body thrown into hell. If your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away! It is much better for you to lose one of your limbs than to have your whole body go off to hell. "It was also said, 'Anyone who divorces his wife must give her a written notice of divorce.' But now I tell you; if a man divorces his wife for any cause other than her unfaithfulness, then he is guilty of making her commit adultery if she marries again; and the man who marries her commits adultery also. 'You have also heard that people were told in the past, 'Do not break your promise, but do what you have vowed to the Lord to do. But now I tell you: do not use any vow when you make a promise. Do not swear by heaven, for it is God's throne; nor by earth, for it is the resting place for his feet; nor by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King. Do not even swear by your head, because you cannot make a single hair white or black. Just say yes or No anything else you say comes from the Evil One. (Matthew 5, 17-37)

Reflection

In the bible readings for this week Jesus comes to offer us a better way than just the mere law. He invites us to love God and others, which is what pleases God. Jesus says that his friends go beyond what they supposed to do. They love him so much, that they really want to do things as he likes them. Is it easy for you to ask forgiveness from someone who is angry at you? Is it hard for you to let go of your anger when someone has hurt you? Ask Jesus for help to forgive. Tell him what you want to do.


Activity

Bring to the group flash cards. Ask the children to write on the back of the card a name of a person with whom they have fought and now would like to make up. Bring them to the altar of the group and pray together "I want to be with you, Jesus"







Teaching about Revenge

I tell you: do not take revenge on someone who wrongs you. If anyone slaps you on the right cheek, let him slap your left cheek too. And if someone takes you to court to sue you for your shirt, let him have your coat as well. And if one of the occupation troops forces you to carry his pack one mile, carry it two miles. When someone asks you for something, give it to him; when someone wants to borrow something, lend it to him.

"You have heard that it was said, 'Love your friends, hate your enemies. 'But now I tell you: love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, so that you may become the children of your Father in heaven. For he makes his sun to shine on bad and good people alike and gives rain to those who do good and those who do evil. Why should God reward you if you love only the people who love you? Even the tax collectors do that! And if you speak only to your friends, have you done anything out of the ordinary? Even the pagans do that! You must be perfect just as your Father in heaven is perfect. (Matthew 5, 38-48)

Reflection




