
Numbers 21: 4-9; Psalm 77; Phillipians 2: 6-11; John 3: 13-17

Jesus must be lifted up

Jesus said to Nicodemus: "No one has gone up to heaven except the one who has come down from heaven, the Son of Man. And just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life." For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him.

Reflection

On the following page, read the summary of the Old Testament story about Moses and the serpents. Why is God angry with the people? (The people complain that God took them out of Egypt to starve; they are tired of the bread God provides. They don't trust God's plan to take them to the Promised Land. God wants His people to trust Him and the great love He has for them. He wants them to realize that only He can give them true happiness.) Have you ever complained about something? Share. Can you think of a reason that this situation may have helped you in some way? Share. God was compassionate to His people despite their complaints and He cured them with the snake on the stick. The gospel compares the snake on the stick to what? (Jesus on the Cross.) Why does God allow **Jesus to die on the cross?** (God loves us so much that He gave His only Son so we would not perish.) From what does Jesus heal us? (Jesus' cross heals our souls from our sins and gives us Eternal Life.) How are we saved? (Believing in and loving Jesus and sharing that love.) Jesus says that contemplating His cross helps us with life's difficulties. How? (He gives us strength, comfort, peace, wisdom... to face problems with love.)

On the following page, read and color the story of Moses and the Serpents. On the next page, follow instructions to make the craft about God's love; on the back, write a difficulty you would like Jesus to help you with. On the last page, unscramble the words from the Gospel.

Prayer

Lord, enter into my heart. Your presence heals me. Give me your love, your light, your strength to face my difficulties. Jesus, I trust in you. Amen.








So, the people complained against God and Moses, "Why have you brought us up from Egypt to die in the wilderness, where there is no food or water? We are disgusted with this wretched food!"






