

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

ST. JOSEPH THE WORKER

This is St. Joseph's second feast day on the Church calendar of celebrations. We honor him also on March 19. St. Joseph is very important saint. He is the husband of Our Lady and the foster-father of Jesus.

Today we celebrate his witness of hard work. He was carpenter who worked long hours in his little shop. St. Joseph teaches us that the work we do is important. Through it we give our contribution and our services to our family and society. But even more than that. As Christians we realize that our work is like a mirror of ourselves. That is why we want our work to be done with diligence.

Many countries set aside one day a year to honor workers. This encourages the dignity and appreciation of work. The Church has given us a wonderful model of work, St. Joseph. In 1955, Pope Pius XII proclaimed this feast of St. Joseph the Worker to be celebrated every year.

We can ask St. Joseph to help us become more diligent in our study and work:

Saint Joseph, husband of Mary, you were always aware of God's presence.

Help me find God in my life, and be with me at the hour of my death.



Activity


Write a list of names of persons that you know that experience Jesus' presence every day. Share the names of the persons. Which one catch your attention?



BIBLE STORY JESUS ASCENDS INTO HEAVEN Acts 1:1-11









Directions:

Materials:

Pencil Scissors

Glue

Ruler

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
- 1. Duplicate the picture of Jesus color and cut it out
- 2. Cut a 1" strip from the side of the blue construction paper
- 3. Glue the picture of Jesus to the bottom of the strip
- 4. Trace handprints on white paper. Cut them out and glue them on the construction paper to represent clouds
- 5. Make a 1 1/4" slit towards the top of the construction paper. Fit the end of the blue strip in it, with the figure of Jesus showing among the clouds
- 6. Glue several handprints on either side of the slit. Leave the bottoms of the hands unglued so the figure of Jesus can be hidden beneath them
- 7. Write "The Lord is with me" on one of the handprint clouds and glue it, to the top of the picture.
- 8. Tell the story of Jesus' ascension into heaven, pulling up the strip to hide Jesus in the clouds as you do so. Remember that though Jesus went up into heaven, He is still with you all the time

Other ideas:

- Glue cotton on the handprint clouds.
- 2. Omit the strip of paper and the slit. Glue the figure of Jesus in the sky

Reflecting

Have you ever heard people talk without understanding them? How was this situation solve? Is there peace patience, joy and respect in our home?

Families and communities are unable to communicate because of pride. How do we communicate in our families? Do we try to understand one another? The disciples were very afraid but when they received The Holy Spirit everything was change. For The Holy Spirit there are no foreign languages. Every one can understand the language of love. The apostles received the special gifts of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. We receive them at our Confirmation.

Activity

Read Acts 2,1-11

Seat the children in a circle.

Darken the room. Explain them that we are going to pray like when Mary and The Apostles were gather together. Prepare tongues of fire drawn on construction paper. Behind each tongue write one of the fruits of the Spirit.

Place them on the head of each children. When the prayer is finish pray over each one for the gift they have receive.

Prayer

Lord Jesus Christ, Your peace is our greatest gift. Help us to treasure this gift and to know how to use all the gifts You have given us. Amen. The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and holy fear.





Activity


Light a candle. Show the flame, the wax, and the wick. It has three different parts but one candle.

Prayer


