Ascension of the Lord - June 5, 2011

Readings: Acts 1, 1-11; Psalm 46; Ephesians 1, 17-23; Matthew 28: 16-20

The eleven disciples went to the hill in Galilee where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshiped him, even though some of them doubted. Jesus drew near and said to them, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. Go, then, to all peoples everywhere and make them my disciples: baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey everything I have commanded you. And I will be with you always, to the end of the age."

(Matthew 28:16-20)

Reflection

In today's Gospel we can feel ourselves deeply loved as we hear the words of Jesus prayer at the Last Supper.

The wonderful thing about this Gospel is that through Jesus we learn to love and we grow in faith, Jesus is with us today! Jesus ascended to Heaven so that He might be with us always.

The disciples had a mission and we have a mission too. How are you doing it?

Activity

Prayer


Lord help me to fulfill the mission.

Sunday of Pentecost - June 12, 2011 Readings: Acts 2, 1-11; Psalm 103; 1Corinthians 12, 3-7; John 20, 19-23

Jesus appears to His disciples

It was late that Sunday evening, and the disciples were gathered together behind locked doors, because they were afraid of the Jewish authorities. Then Jesus came and stood among them. Peace be with you," he said. After saying this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples were filled with joy at seeing the Lord. Jesus said to them again. "Peace be with you. As the Father sent me, so I send you."Then he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive peoples sins, they are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven." One of the twelve disciples, Thomas (called the twin), was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!" Thomas said to them, "Unless I see the scars of the nails in his hands and put my finger on those scars and my hand in his side, I will not believe." (John 20, 19-25)

Reflection

Have you ever heard people talk without understanding them? How was this situation solve? Is there peace patience, joy and respect in our home? Families and communities are unable to communicate because of pride. How do we communicate in our families? Do we try to understand one another? The disciples were very afraid but when they received the Holy Spirit everything was change. For the Holy Spirit there are no foreign languages. Every one can understand the language of love. The apostles received the special gifts of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. We receive them at our Confirmation.

Activity

Read Acts 2, 1-11 Seat the children in a circle. Darken the room. Explain them that we are going to pray like when Mary and the Apostles were gather together. Prepare tongues of fire drawn on construction paper. Behind each tongue write one of the Fruits of the Spirit. Place them on the head of each children. When the prayer is finish pray over each one for the gift they have receive.

Prayer

Lord Jesus Christ, Your peace is our greatest gift. Help us to treasure this gift and to know how to use all the gifts you have given us.

Amen

The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are: Wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and holy fear.







DO YOU KNOW WHICH ARE THE GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT?

Spirit of FORTITUDE, give strength to my soul in every time of trouble or danger. Let me never offend God by willful sin. Strengthen me against temptation.


Sprit of KNOWLEDGE, help me to know good from evil. Teach me to do what is right in the sight of God.

Most Holy Trinity - June 19, 2011

Readings: Exodus 34, 4-6, 8-9; Psalm Daniel 3; 2Corinthians 13, 11-13; John 3, 16-18

God's Love for the world

For God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not die but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the

world to be its judge, but to be its savior. Those who believe in the Son are not judged; but those who do not believe have already been judged, because they have not believed

in God's only Son. (John 3, 16-18)

Reflection

Do you know what a mystery is? It's something that's very difficult to understand, right? That's the Most Holy Trinity, God himself, Father, Son and Holy spirit, three different persons and one true God. The most important thing for understanding this mystery is not the reason but the faith.

Activity

Light a candle. Show the flame, the wax and the wick. It has tree different parts but one candle. In God there are three different persons Father, Son and Holy Spirit but one true God.


Prayer

Corpus Christi - June 26, 2011

Readings: Deuteronomy 8, 2-3.14a; Psalm 147; 1Corinthians 10, 16-17; John 6, 51-58

I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If you eat this bread, you will live forever. The bread that I will give you is my flesh, which I give so that the world may live." This started an angry argument among them. "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" they asked. Jesus said to them, "I am telling you the truth: if you do not eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you will not have life in yourselves.

Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood have eternal life, and I will raise them to life on the last day. For my flesh is the real food; my blood is the real drink. Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood live in me, and I live in them. The living Father sent me, and because of him I live also. In the same way whoever eats me will live because of me. This, then, is the bread that came down from heaven; it is not like the bread that your ancestors ate, but then later died. Those who eat this bread will live forever, (John 6, 51-58)

Reflection

Talk with the children about being hungry. Can they imagine how many children suffer because they don't have anything to eat? Besides food, what other things can we be hungry for? What would we really like people to do for us? What do our moms, grandparents, and friends want us to do for them? How do we do it? Share

Activity




Prayer




Crossword
