Jesus appears to His disciples

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." (John 20, 19-23)

Reflection


Have you ever heard people talk without understanding them? How was this situation solved? Is there peace, patience, joy and respect in our home? Families and communities are unable to communicate because of pride. How do we communicate in our families? Do we try to understand one another? The disciples were very afraid but when they received the Holy Spirit everything was changed. For the Holy Spirit, there are no foreign languages. Everyone can understand the language of love. The apostles received the special gifts of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. We receive them at our Confirmation.

Activity

Read Acts 2, 1-11. Seat the children in a circle. Darken the room. Explain to them that we are going to pray like when Mary and the Apostles were gathered together. Prepare tongues of fire drawn on construction paper. Behind each tongue write one of the Fruits of the Spirit. Place them on the head of each child. When the prayer is finished, pray over each one for the gift they have received.

Prayer

Lord Jesus Christ, your peace is our greatest gift. Help us to treasure this gift and to know how to use all the gifts you have given us. Amen.












INSIDE OF THIS BOX YOU WILL FIND THE GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT


In each card of the small gift boxes write the name of the gift. On the bottom, you will find a list of words, among them are the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit. Can you find them?








- Make me seek You with my whole soul, and find You, my best and truest Friend.

Friends of Jesus and Mary Most Holy Trinity - June 11, 2017

Readings: Exodus 34, 4-6, 8-9; Psalm Daniel 3; 2Corinthians 13, 11-13; John 3, 16-18

God's Love for the world

God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him will not be condemned, but whoever does not believe has already been condemned, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. (John 3, 16-18)

Reflection

Do you know what a mystery is? It's something that's very difficult to understand, right? That's the Most Holy Trinity, God himself, Father, Son and Holy spirit, three different persons and one true God. The most important thing for understanding this mystery is not the reason but the faith.

Activity

Light a candle. Show the flame, the wax and the wick. It has three different parts but one candle. In God, there are three different persons Father, Son and Holy Spirit but one true God.

Prayer

Each child can give thanks for his family and for being part of the family of God. All respond: Glory to the Father, to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. Amen.







Friends of Jesus and Mary Corpus Christi - June 18, 2017

Readings: Deuteronomy 8, 2-3.14a; Psalm 147; 1Corinthians 10, 16-17; John 6, 51-58

Jesus said to the Jewish crowds: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever." (John 6, 51-58)

Reflection


Talk with the children about being hungry. Can they imagine how many children suffer because they don't have anything to eat? Besides food, what other things can we be hungry for? What would we really like for people to do for us? What do our moms, grandparents, and friends want us to do for them? How do we do it? Share.

Activity

Prepare an invitation for a friend or relative who does not go to Mass. Tell him you will wait for him next Sunday. Make a place in your heart for Jesus doing something special for someone this week. Try to visit Jesus at church.



12th Sunday in Ordinary Time / June 25, 2017

Readings: Jeremiah 20,10-13; Psalm 68; Romans 5,12-15; Matthew 10,26-33

Whom shall we fear?

Jesus said to the Twelve: "Fear no one. Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, nor secret that will not be known. What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light; what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops. And do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna. Are not two sparrows sold for a small coin? Yet not one of them falls to the ground without your Father's knowledge. Even all the hairs of your head are counted. So, do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows. Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father. But whoever denies me before others, I will deny before my heavenly Father." (Mathew 10, 26-33)

Reflection


Talk with the children about some things they fear. Of what are they most afraid (darkness, animals, monsters, or a person)? With whom do they feel more secure? Who makes them feel important? Who is more important for them? Do they sometimes feel like making fun of them because they behave properly? Are they sometimes afraid to do the right thing because they will make fun of them? Jesus said that we must proclaim his message of love, although some persons don't like it. Share.

Activity

Motivate the children to do something special this week. Example: Behave in class, although the classmates make fun of them. Give thanks for all older people for doing something for them. Give them a blank piece of paper. On one side make a drawing of them. Cut it. On the back write "I AM IMPORTANT FOR GOD".

Prayer

Jesus, please protect me when I am afraid. I thank you for taking care of me. Thank you, because you consider me more valuable than the birds. Help me to understand and proclaim your message of love to others although sometimes they do not like it. Amen.
