The Parable of the Found Treasure.

Jesus said to his disciples: "The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field, which a person finds and hides again, and out of joy goes and sells all that he has and buys that field. Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant searching for fine pearls. When he finds a pearl of great price, he goes and sells all that he has and buys it."

Reflection

What is the Kingdom of **Heaven?** The presence of Jesus in our hearts. Iesus knows it is difficult to describe the immense value of the Kingdom of Heaven, so He uses parables which compare the Kingdom to things we can understand. First, He compares it to what? A treasure buried in a field. What does the person do when he **finds it?** He hides it again; then he goes and sells everything he has to buy the field. What is the second comparison Jesus **uses?** A merchant of fine pearls finds one of great value; he sells everything to buy it.



What is Jesus telling us with these stories? Nothing we have is more valuable than having Jesus in our hearts. Why is it so valuable to have Jesus in our heart? Jesus gives us everything we need to be happy in this life and in the next. He protects us and guides us to grow in love, service, peace, forgiveness, joy and all we need to get to eternal happiness in Heaven.


