

#### Jesus Heals a Leper

A leper came to Jesus and kneeling down begged him and said, "If you wish, you can make me clean." Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand, touched him, "I do will it. Be made clean." The leprosy left him immediately, and he was made clean. Then, warning him sternly, he dismissed him at once. He said to him, "See that you tell no one anything, but go, show yourself to the priest and offer for your cleansing what Moses prescribed; that will be proof for them." The man went away and began to publicize the whole matter. He spread the report abroad so that it was impossible for Jesus to enter a town openly. He remained outside in deserted places, and people kept coming to him from everywhere.

### Reflection

What is a leper? (A person who has leprosy, a contagious disease that eats the flesh.) How did a leper live? (They lived isolated from their family and friends, without working so as not to spread the disease. They were ashamed because everyone thought this was a result of their sins.) How does the leper in the gospel show his faith in Jesus? (With much humility, kneeling before Him, he begs to be cured.) How does Jesus cure him? (He stretched out His hand and touched him saying, "I do will it..." Touching a leper was very dangerous.) Jesus approaches those that everyone avoids.



Is there someone in your school or neighborhood who has a disability or sickness that makes people avoid them? How can you show compassion for this person as Jesus did? Share. Why does Jesus ask him to present himself to the priest and offer a sacrifice to be purified according to the law of Moses? (He is thus purified on the inside; also, the priest will permit him to go back to the community.) The leper went to tell everyone what Jesus had done for him. How do you show gratitude to God for blessings He has given you? Share.




