*Acts 14, 21b-27; Psalm 144; Revelation 21, 1-5a; John 13, 31-33a. 34-35*

### A New Commandment

When Judas had left them, Jesus said, "Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in him. If God is glorified in him, God will also glorify him in himself, and God will glorify him at once. My children, I will be with you only a little while longer. I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

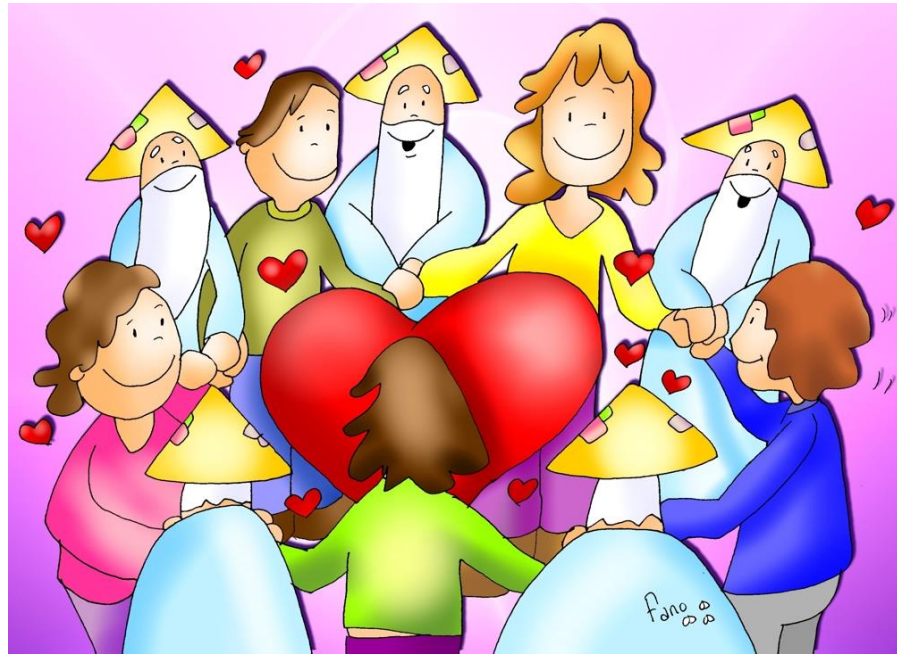
### Reflection

**Jesus confirms again that He and His Father are one. When He is glorified, so is the Father. Thus, the commandments that Jesus gives, come from God the Father.**

**Jesus gives us a new commandment.**

**What new commandment does Jesus give us? (...love one another as I have loved you.)**

**How did Jesus love when He was on earth? (He prayed for all, taught them about God, cured them and their families, fed them, forgave their sins, and suffered and died for all...) Jesus says, "This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another". Do you think the people around you realize that you are a disciple of Jesus? Share. How can we love each other better so that people can see that we are Jesus' disciples? Share.**

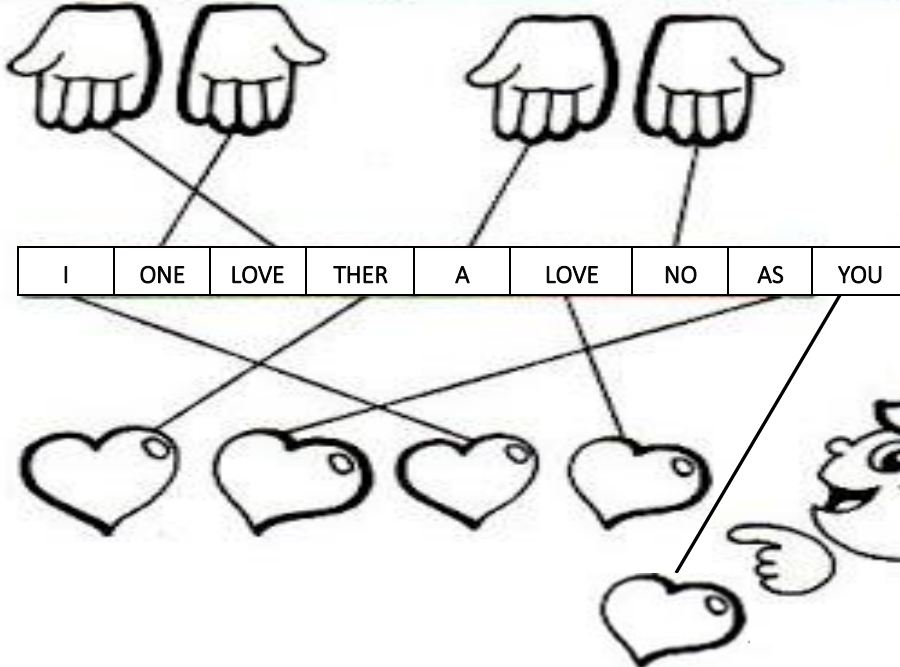

Solution: Love one another as I love you.

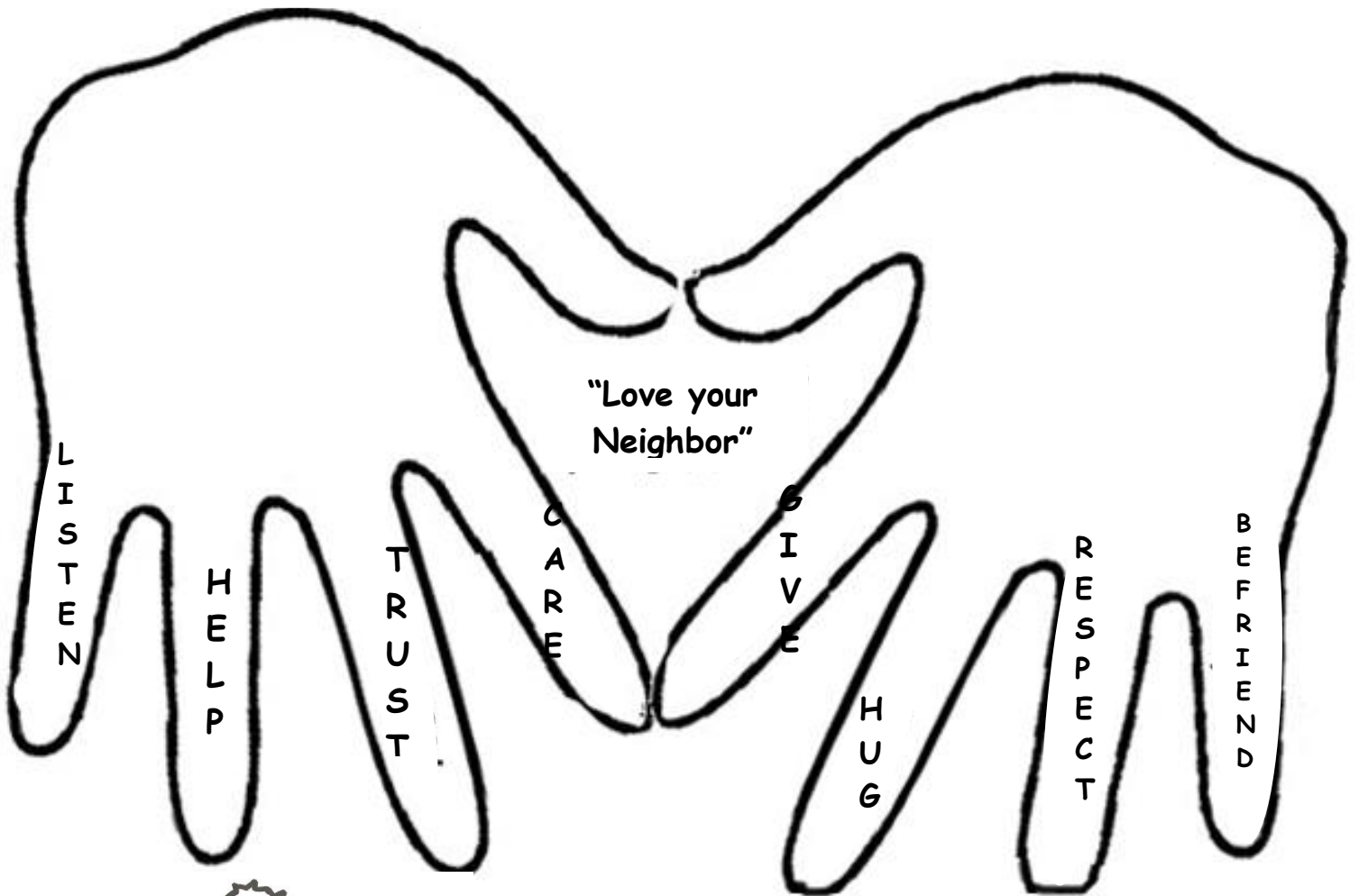
