Cycle C – XI Sunday of Ordinary Time

Acts 2, 1-11; Psalm 103; Romans 8, 8-17; John 14, 15-16.23-26

Solemnity of the Holy Trinity

Jesus said to his disciples: "I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth. He will not speak on his own, but he will speak what he hears, and will declare to you the things that are coming. He will glorify me, because he will take from what is mine and declare it to you. Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason, I told you that he will take from what is mine and declare it to you."

Reflection

Jesus says that by ourselves, we cannot understand God. Who does God send to help us understand? (The Spirit of Truth/the Holy Spirit) How does Jesus say here that the Holy Spirit helps us? (He will guide us to all truth and declare all things that are coming.) When we pray, the Holy Spirit leaves inspirations in our heart to guide us. Have you ever felt the Holy Spirit guiding you? Share. From whom does the Holy Spirit receive the truth and what is to come? (From Jesus) From whom does Jesus receive the Truth? (From God the Father) The thoughts of God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit are the same because they are one God, but three persons. We call our God, the Holy Trinity because "tri" means three, and unity: three in union. It is a mystery of our faith that we cannot understand, but we accept it because Jesus taught us this mystery of the Holy Trinity and He is Truth.

Activity

On the following page, cut, color, and glue the clover onto a colored construction paper. Punch a hole on top and put a ribbon through it for hanging. Compare a shamrock: 3 leaves, but still 1 shamrock, with the Holy Trinity: 1 God, but 3 persons. Watch the movie on the Holy Trinity included there. See the second form on the next page drawn with 1 line, you have 3 forms (Similar to a triangle: 1 shape, 3 corners). On the last page, complete the word search.

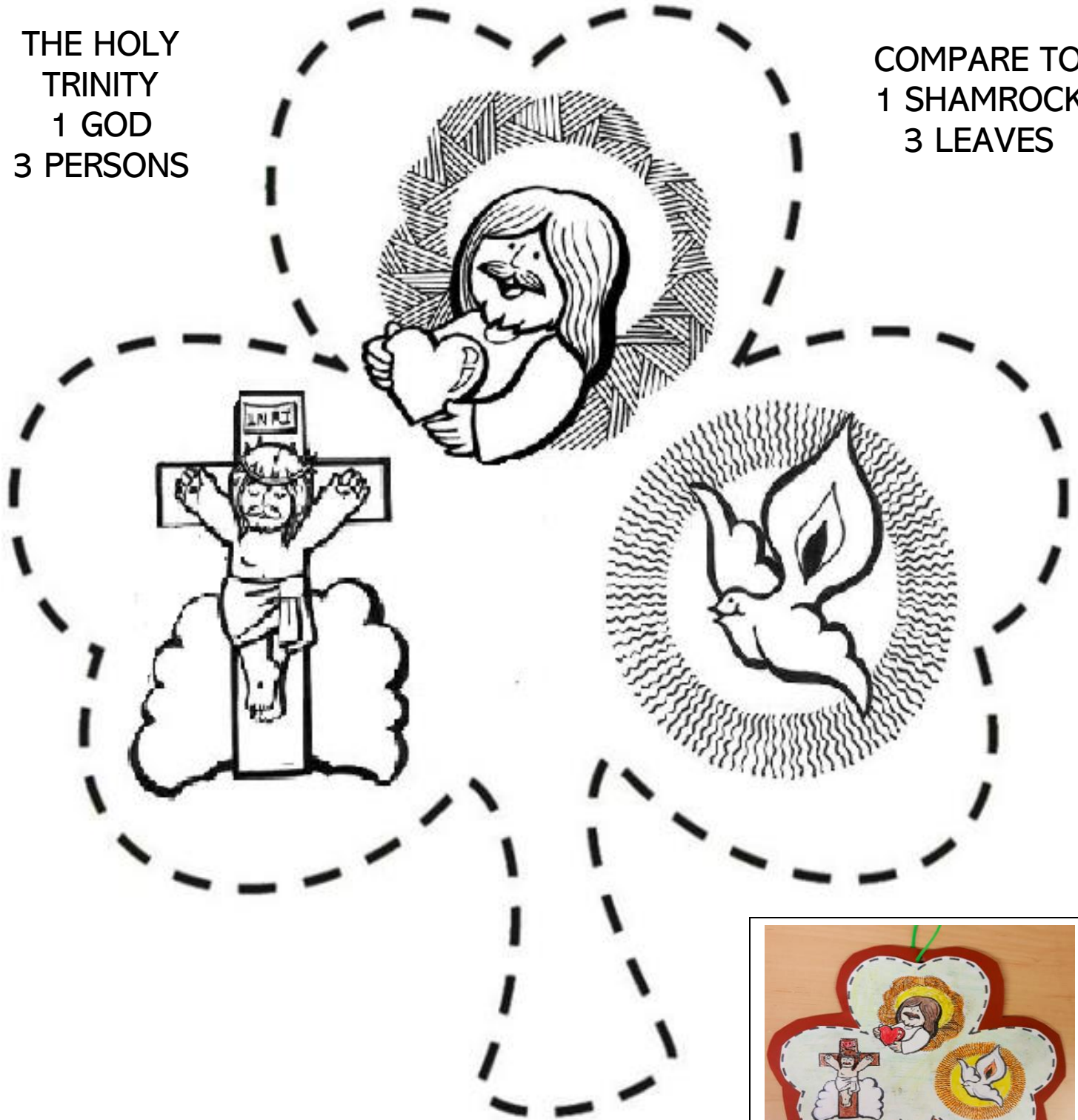
