

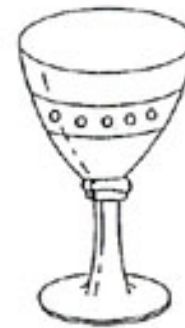

## THE EUCHARIST IS A SACRAMENT OF UNITY AND LOVE

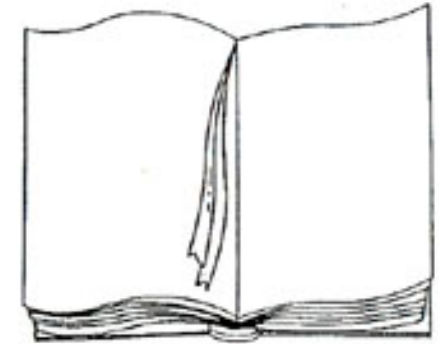
Color and cut out the seven mobile pieces. To make your pieces sturdier, paste each one on a piece of construction paper and cut it out again. Decide how you want to hang your mobile pieces. Using a pencil, carefully punch the holes you need in each mobile piece. Pull a piece of string or yarn through each hole. Hang the pieces from a piece of wood or a clothes hanger. Hang your mobile in some special place to help you remember that in the Eucharist Christ gives us himself as Word and as food.

Jesus says, "I myself am the bread of life. No one who comes to me shall ever be hungry, no one who believes in me shall ever thirst."

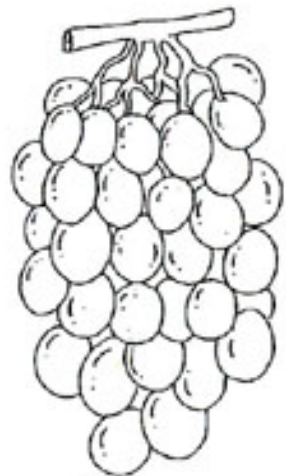

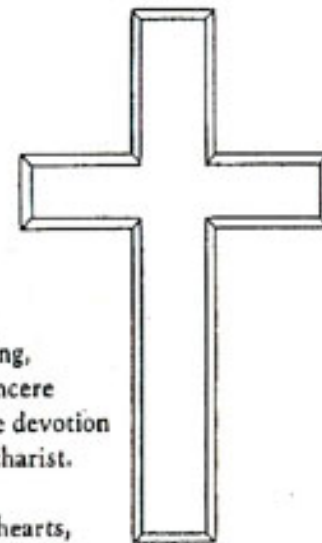

peace and joy.

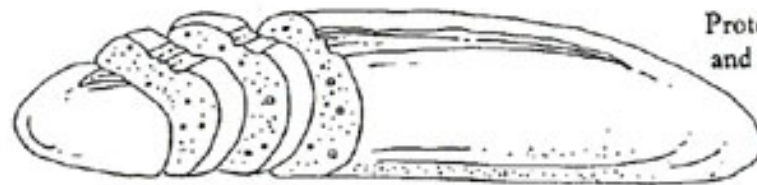
Protect and deliver us from all evil
