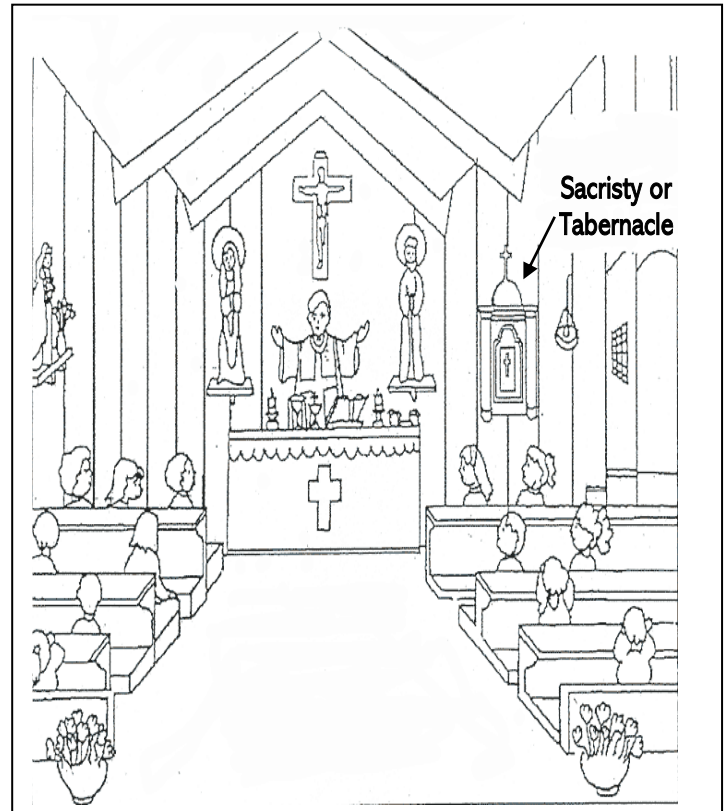
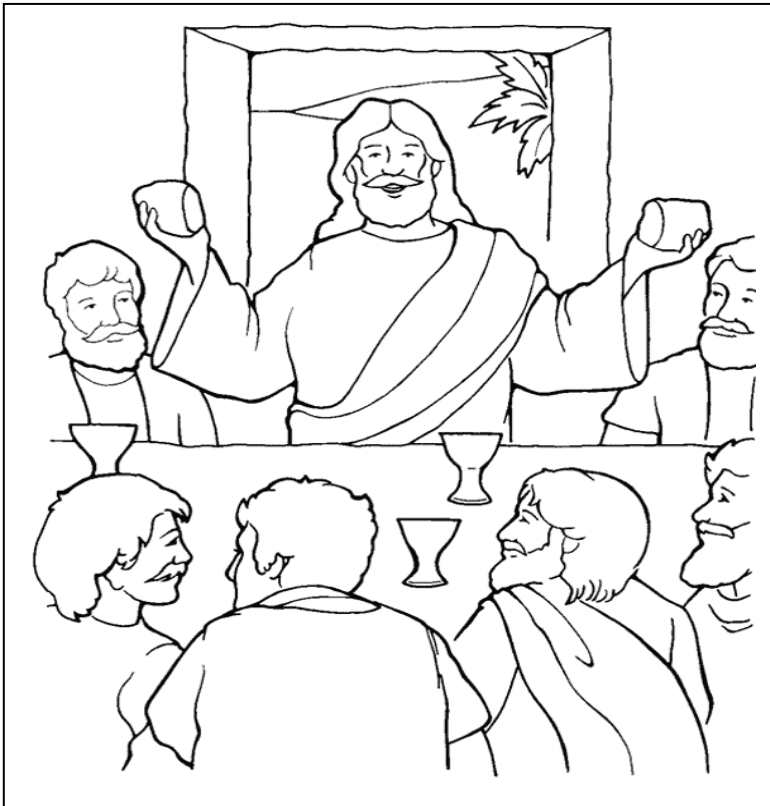




### HOLY THURSDAY

When Jesus celebrates the Last Supper with His apostles, He gives us the Holy Eucharist and our Holy Priests. He teaches us how to serve one another by washing His apostle's feet.



### THE REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS

The **CONSECRATION** is when the priest repeats the words Jesus said at the Last Supper. He takes the host and says:

**“Take this bread and eat it; this is my Body, which will be given up for you.” He takes the cup and says, “Take this cup and drink from it; this is the cup of my Blood, Blood of the new and everlasting covenant which will be shed for you and for all men so that sins may be forgiven. Do this in memory of me.”**

Jesus becomes truly present in the **EUCCHARIST**: what appears as bread and wine is the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. We call this change, **TRANSUBSTANTIATION**.

In the Eucharist, Jesus relives the sacrifice at the cross. We remember that Jesus died for all people and resurrected to give us life and salvation.
