Jeremiah 33, 14-16; Psalm 24; 1Thessalonians 3:12-4, 2; Lucas 21, 25-28,34-36

Be Alert...

Jesus said to his disciples: "There will be signs in the sun, the moon, and the stars, and on earth nations will be in dismay, perplexed by the roaring of the sea and the waves. People will die of fright in anticipation of what is coming upon the world, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. And then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. But when these signs begin to happen, stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand. "Beware that your hearts do not become drowsy from carousing and drunkenness and the anxieties of daily life, and that day catch you by surprise like a trap. For that day will assault everyone who lives on the face of the earth. Be vigilant at all times and pray that you have the strength to escape the tribulations that are imminent and to stand before the Son of Man."

Reflection

The gospel speaks of the second coming of Jesus and the signs that will happen before. They are described, not to scare us, but so we may be prepared and protected by Jesus because we do not know when they will happen. What does the gospel say we should do continuously? (Avoid vices and pray.) Prayer brings us close to God so He can guide us on the right path. Every year at Christmas time, we celebrate the first time Jesus came to earth, when He was born in a stable in Bethlehem. Every year He is born in our heart. What are the signs that show Christmas is approaching? (Christmas decorations in the stores and in



houses, Christmas songs on the radio, Christmas cards arrive and are written.) **How should we prepare our heart so it's ready for Jesus on Christmas Day?** (Also avoiding vices, praying often, sharing with and helping others, offering small sacrifices to Jesus...) **This pleases Him greatly.**





Instructions:

- 1. Cut the calendar and the ítems on this page.
- Cut 4 strips of brown construction paper (8x3.5"). Cut lines from the bottom towards the top, 1 and 1/8" apart and leaving 1/8" above to glue to the calendar.
- 3. Cut a triangle on brown paper. (Base 9", height 4", sides 6")
- 4. Glue the calendar onto a paper (11x17"), starting with the 2nd page of the calendar on the bottom border.
- 5. Glue the strips to the top of each week.
- 6. Glue the roof (triangle) to the top.
- 7. Cut and color Mary and Joseph and the message: "Lets accompany..." and glue to the roof.
- 8. Cut the symbols and glue to the week to which they correspond.
- 9. Glue the prophesies to the top corners.
