

Informed Consent for Juvéderm® Vycross® Technology

Patient Name

The Vycross® collection of Juvéderm® (VOLBELLA®, VOLIFT®, VOLUMA®, VOLITE®, VOLUX®) represents the latest innovation in hyaluronic acid dermal fillers. These products have been designed using a unique, patented combination of low- and high-molecular weight hyaluronic acid technology for more efficient cross-linking. This may result in reduced swelling, enhanced smoothness, and longer duration when compared to the more traditional hylacross Juvéderm® fillers (Ultra XC and Ultra Plus XC).

☐ **Common side-effects** are swelling and bruising after injection. Some patients experience paresthesia ("pins and needles") or irritation at the injection site(s).

☐ **Caution** should be used in patients with a history of herpes simplex (cold sores can sometimes become reactivated by fillers), bleeding disorders, or those on immunosuppressive therapy.

☐ All dermal fillers must be avoided if a patient is pregnant or breastfeeding. A history of anaphylaxis or severe allergies to these products is a contraindication as well.

☐ Notify the doctor if you have had any dermal fillers in the past (including type and location). Adding different types of fillers to the same location can result in granulomas / scarring (this is generally not true when adding the different Vycross® and hylacross types of Juvéderm® together).

☐ **Serious** but very rare complications could include vascular occlusions (blood clots), resulting in necrosis/scarring of the face or even **blindness**.

☐ **Aftercare:** Swelling, especially in the lips, can last 2-4 days but may be improved with cool compresses. Patients should avoid the sun, smoking and alcohol for 2-3 days after having fillers injected. Full and final effects are expected around the 14-day mark.

☐ I consent to have my photo taken before any filler procedure, as well as after if there is any complication or undesired cosmetic effect. Such photo's will only be used for medical documentation.

Clinic Policies

- \$500 non-refundable deposit is required to book a 45-minute Vycross® treatment.
- Full-payment is required before any Vycross® is actually injected. This can be done directly with the doctor in the room once the final treatment has been decided (see fees on reverse page).
- The practice of medicine is not an exact science and as such, no guarantees can be given concerning the results of any cosmetic procedure performed at our clinic.
- In the event of unsatisfactory cosmetic result, we will offer to use a reversal agent (hyaluronidase) if required a minimum of 2 weeks after the procedure, at no cost to the patient.
- **We will not provide a refund or free re-injection of any filler service performed, regardless of the cosmetic outcome.**
