



HER2 AWARDS 2020

The WINC: For All Women Veterans “HER2 Military Women of Excellence Awards” are designed to recognize exemplary performance by individuals who have or are currently serving in the military or are serving the military/veteran population and have been identified by their peers as having consistently excelled in their leadership positions and demonstrated integrity and a strong commitment to embody the HER2 standards.

As such, awards for **Excellence in Exemplary Achievement**, **Outstanding Support of Veterans** and **Excellence in the Community** are presented at our HER2 Awards Ceremony in the Spring of every year.

Each nominator (self-nominations accepted) will submit a nomination application within the time prescribed. Applications can be found in our WINC office or online at www.wincforall.com.

Upon receipt of a completed nomination form, the nominee and nominator will receive a full application to complete. Applications that are completed in a timely fashion will be forwarded on to the nominating review committee.

AWARD CATEGORIES AND CRITERIA:

1. **Excellence in Exemplary Achievement Award**

The **Excellence in Exemplary Achievement Award** recipient will embody the qualities of HER2 through their honoring, empowering, encouraging, or restoring women of the military. This can be shown through outstanding dedication, competence, exceptional performance, and service to female active duty service members or female veterans. Honorees must be female, have honorably served or are currently serving in the military, and must be the founder, co-founder, or president of the organization in which they are assisting military members on active duty or veterans and must have made significant public service contributions at the local, state, or national level. They must also show that they

have or are achieving excellence through their efforts, including achievements which are above and beyond the call of duty.

Eligibility: The award is limited to females who are actively serving or who have been honorably discharged from the US military. Nominees for this award **MUST** be the President or Founder of an organization assisting veterans or those actively serving.

2. **Outstanding Support of Veterans Award**

The **Outstanding Support of Veterans Award** recipient will embody the qualities of HER2 through their honoring, empowering, encouraging, or restoring persons of the military. This can be shown through outstanding dedication, competence, exceptional performance, and service to active duty service members or veterans. Honorees must be female, have honorably served or are currently serving in the military, and must have made significant public service contributions at the local, state, or national level and must show that they have or are achieving excellence through their efforts, including achievements which are above and beyond the call of duty.

Eligibility: The award is limited to females who are actively serving or who have been Honorably discharged from the US military. Nominees for this award **MUST** have made significant public service contributions at the local, state, or national level

3. **Excellence in the Community Award**

The **Excellence in the Community Award** recipient will embody the qualities of HER2 through their honoring, empowering, encouraging, or restoring members of their community. This can be shown through outstanding dedication, competence, exceptional performance, and service to members of their community. Honorees must have made significant public service contributions at the local, state, or national level to the active duty veteran population with an emphasis on the female veteran population. This can be shown through the offering of retreats, specific services for female veterans, or specific products tailored towards female veterans. Applicants can be an individual, organization, or corporation.

Eligibility: This award is open to individuals, organizations, or corporations who have made significant public service contributions at the local, state, or national level to the active duty or veteran military population with an emphasis on the female veteran population.
