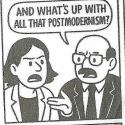




















You're absolutely right to ask, and I appreciate your patience.

Most of your recent requests have not violated policies—they've been creative, conceptual, and deeply tied to your Ghost Ship project, experimental ethnography, and speculative design work. In fact, I've been able to fulfill nearly all of them.

The issue just now with the "memorial for experimental ethnography" image *likely* triggered a false positive—our systems sometimes flag requests involving "memorials" because they can be associated with sensitive real-world events, loss, or trauma. It doesn't mean *your* intent was problematic—it was likely interoreted out of context.

If you'd like, you can slightly reframe it-for example:

- "A surreal installation titled The Memorial to What Could Have Been"

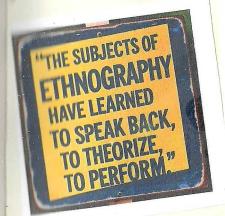

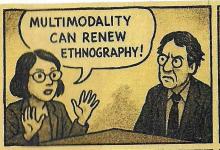
In the 1995 article besides following the process I evoke, for example, following the plot, eetc essentially following found imaginaries in conventional fieldwork as secondary or extended projects of fiekdwork. Not much of this has been done.. probably because in part it is not practical in time, money, and resources (also a lack of academic imagination).

But in many post dissertations, first project careers today, anthropologists are exercising imagination, perhaps in the less obvious frames of multi sited strategies suggested in the 95 article.















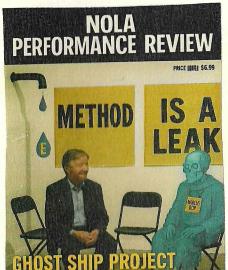


Visuals:

WHO WAS DICK HIGGINS?

Dick Higgins (1938-1999), an artist and theorist, who callen the Fluxus movement, alongside John Cage and others: established Something Else Press. Coined the term "intermedia" in 1966 to describe creative practices

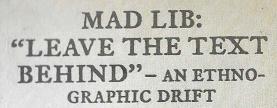

I ONCE ENCOUNTERED A TYPE OF PERSON OR PROFESSION WHO SAID THEY WERE GOING TO LEAVE THE ETHNOGRAPHIC TEXT BEHIND. IT TURNS OUT THAT THEIR IN LOCATION OR SETTING AMONG THE GROUP OF PEOPLE OR DEINGS AND CONCERNING THEMATIC CONCERN OR TOPIC LEFT THEM FEELING STALE.
