There will be a "Quilt Seminar" with demonstrations and a lunch sometime in February--date TBA

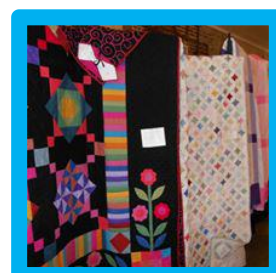
The seminar will begin at 1000 am, but doors will open at 0930 am for seating, and the opportunity to view the quilts in the Museum.
