### **Eligibility Criteria**

To be eligible for consideration, all potential candidates running for an elected position on the Central California Chapter Board position must possess the following qualifications:

- Be a current and active member of NAEYC/CAAIEYC in good standing.
- Time and energy capacity to provide vision, leadership and to serve effectively as a Chapter Board member
- Strong record of commitment to continue making the Central California Chapter of CAAIEYC a high performing, inclusive organization; and,
- Specific skills and qualifications appropriate to the relevant Board position description of responsibilities
- Strong interpersonal skills with ability to objectively consider various perspectives to guide major policy decisions of the Chapter

### **Preferred Criteria**

Additional preferred criteria for the Central California Chapter Board positions to support a continued effective and appropriate presence in the member service area include:

- Previously served on an NAEYC Affiliate or CAAIEYC Chapter Board of Directors
- Participated on a CAAIEYC committee or a committee for a local NAEYC Affiliate or CAAIEYC Chapter
- Leadership experience and/or strong leadership potential with commitment and contributions to early care and education programs, services, agencies, etc.
- Active participation in other organization or agency leadership or programming
- Understanding and familiarity with CAAIEYC's mission, philosophy, goals and code of ethics, and those of the Central California Chapter of CAAIEYC
- Awareness and familiarity of public policy issues as it relates to the field of early care and education, locally, statewide and nationally
