



2019 Past Presidents Legacy Scholarship Award

Guidelines:

The Central California Association for the Education of Young Children, announces the 2019 **Past Presidents Legacy Scholarship** in honor of **Marilyn Mikow**. This scholarship is opened as a one-time scholarship to those who hold a Site Supervisor Permit or Director Permit who are currently working in the early care and education field and demonstrate a commitment to educating children from birth to eight years old. One individual will be selected as the Marilyn Mikow Scholar and awarded a one-time scholarship valuing approximately \$200, which includes entry to all Central California Chapter trainings for the 2019-2020 academic years to support their continued professional development.

Available Scholarship:

\$200 value available for individuals who have demonstrated leadership abilities in the early childhood education field working with children ages birth to eight years old.

This scholarship valuing \$200 will include one year's paid comprehensive membership (or renewal) to CAAEYC and entry to all Central California Chapter's professional development workshops for the 2019-2020 academic year. Dates for this year's professional development include: November 7th, 2019, February 20th, 2020, March 19th, 2020, and May 2nd, 2020.

Scholarship Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking individuals who have demonstrated leadership abilities in the early childhood education field who hold a CA Credential Permit of **Site Supervisor or Director**.
- * Applicants must meet all requirements and submit a complete application.
- * Application deadline is **November 4, 2019**. Late applications are not accepted.
