**You Will Need:** ice cube tray, fruit juice, yoghurt or pudding, a dropper or spoon, plastic wrap, and toothpicks

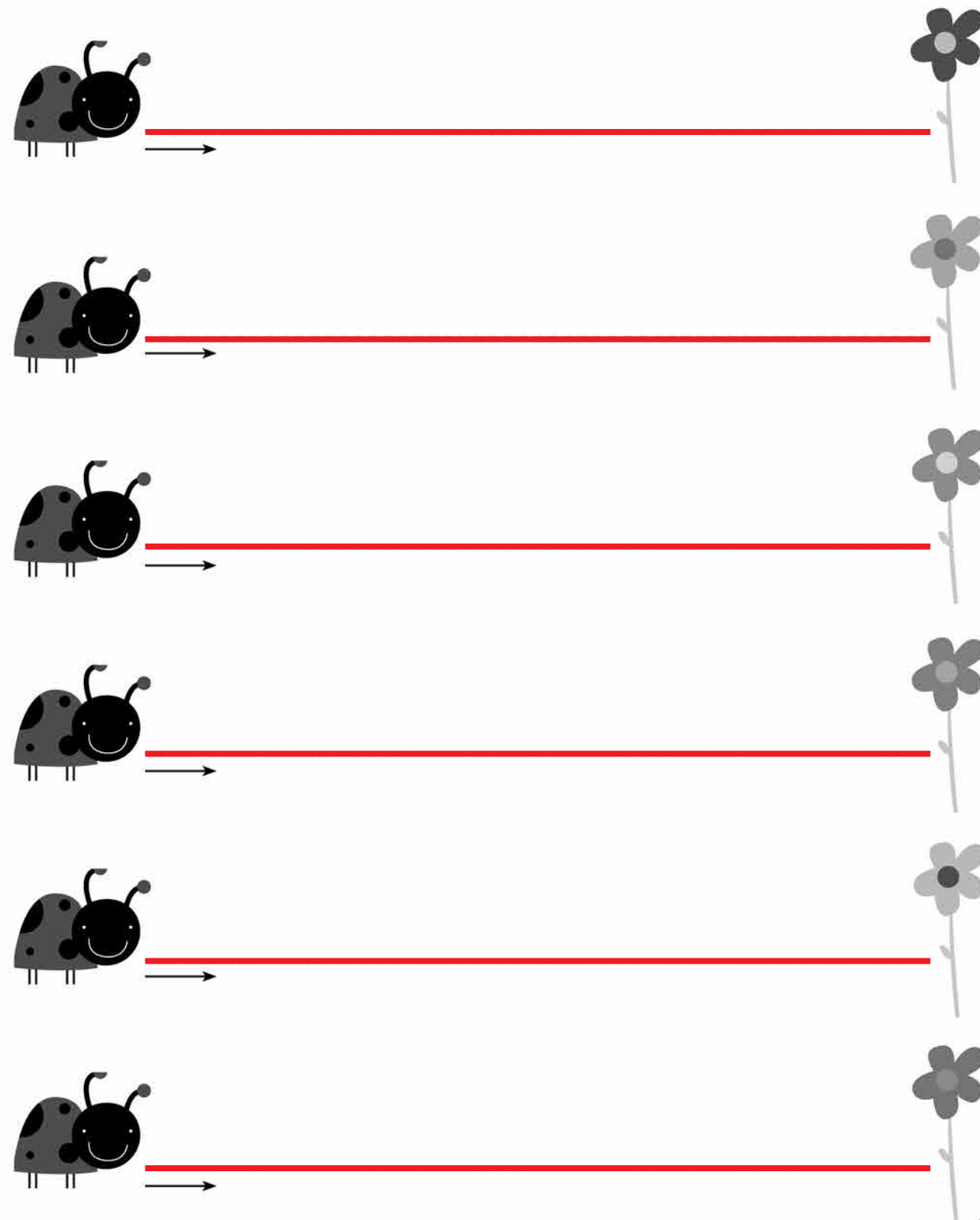
