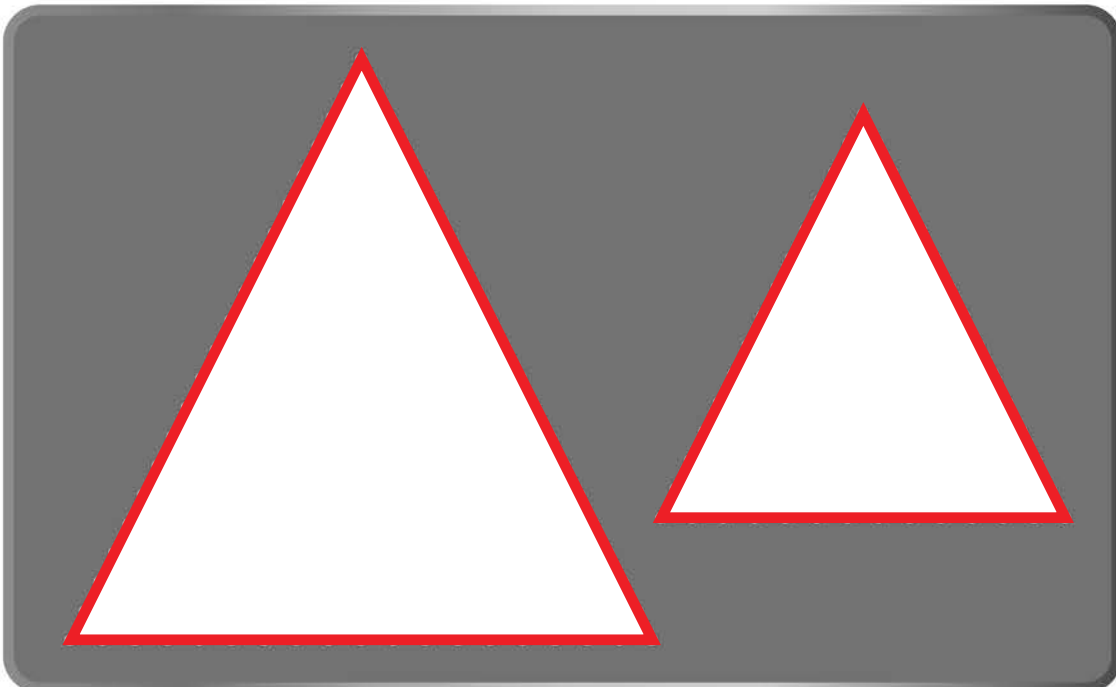
This is a circle. Circles are round. They have no straight sides.
