


SUPER SHAPES


This is a circle. Circles are round. They have no straight sides. Trace the circles and then colour them.




This is a triangle. Triangles have three sides. Trace the triangles and then colour them.



This is a square. Squares have four sides that are all the same length. Trace the squares and then colour them.




This is a rectangle. Rectangles have four sides. Two sides are long and two sides are short. Trace the rectangles and colour them.




