

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD

BENEFITS THE TOWN AS A WHOLE

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE TOWN OF SNOW LAKE SHORES, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and Town employees can take the Town equipment such as back ho, dump truck and tractor out of the Town limits as long as the work being performed benefits the town as a whole.
