Mission:

The Youth Civic Advisory Board (YCAB) serves as a leadership and service initiative that empowers youth to engage in local government, provide input on issues affecting young residents, and promote civic responsibility throughout the City of College Park.

Membership:

Open to all alumni of the 2025 Summer Youth Civic Leadership Academy. Additional applicants from local high schools (ages 13–18) may apply through a formal application process.

Term of Service:

August 24, 2025 – May 10, 2026

(Board will meet monthly on designated dates to be determined.)

Duties and Expectations:

- • Attend monthly advisory board meetings and City events when requested
- • Advise Mayor Pro Tem McKenzie on youth-related concerns and policies
- • Develop and lead at least one community initiative or service project
- • Serve as ambassadors for civic engagement among their peers
- • Maintain good academic standing and a positive disciplinary record

Application Process:

Interested youth must complete an online or paper application by August 10, 2025. The application includes:

- • Personal and parent/guardian information
- • Short response questions on leadership and civic interest
- • A recommendation form from a teacher, counselor, or community leader

Selected members will be notified by August 17, 2025, and inducted at the first official meeting on August 24, 2025.
