A Sanctuary in Blue

This project transformed a dated, closed-off primary bathroom into an open-concept sanctuary with plenty of storage. We achieved this by removing the water closet, a half wall, and the soffit over the shower.

Key features of the new space include:

Walk-in Shower: A curb-less design with a tiled linear drain, a pebble tile floor, and stunning blue porcelain tile walls set with acorn-colored grout. It includes an all-in-one magnetic shower head with a massage feature and two niches, one specifically for shaving.

Freestanding Tub: The blue porcelain tile continues from floor to ceiling, wrapping the slipper-style freestanding tub, which is accented by a chandelier and a tall tub filler with a spray handle.

Vanity Area: A shaker-style double sink vanity is topped with white quartz featuring warm beige veining and a tall linen tower was added for extra storage.

Accents: Black accents on the chandelier, vanity lights, and mirrors contrast beautifully with the brushed nickel plumbing fixtures.

Natural Light and Privacy: A door with a glass insert was added to the entry into the primary bath to draw natural light from the bedroom. For privacy, a rain glass screen was installed near the toilet area, which conveniently holds a towel bar close to the shower entry.

The transformation successfully addressed our clients' needs, with the end result making the space feel twice as large!
