

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

DATE: 19th August 2024

This memorandum of understanding (MoU) is signed between IEEE MUJ and LWT (Learning While Travelling).

This document will come into effect after signing this document on 19Th August 2024.

Party 1: IEEE MUJ,

Party 2: Learning While Travelling

The terms of the MoU to be agreed upon are as follows:

1. Sponsorship Proposal

This MoU states that LWT (Learning While Travelling) is willing to be the Sponsor of Genesis and signing this MoU would confirm the sponsorship. This is also written to clearly state the roles and responsibilities of each party.

1 Responsibilities of IEEE MUJ:

- 1. Making LWT (Learning While Travelling) as the ecosystem/knowledge partner for the event declared on Instagram/LinkedIn.
- 2. Sharing details of the winners and participants (i.e. Phone number, Email ID) within a week of event completion date.

1 Responsibilities of Learning While Travelling:

- 1. Flight Ticket Scholarship worth Rs. 30,000 per person for 6N/7D Amsterdam/Singapore Internship Trip to Winners + Runner-Up
- 2. A total of 40 offers will be provided. 20 for participants and 20 for the working team.

Miscellaneous:

Each Party will be responsible for bearing any costs incurred by it about the execution of this MoU. All notices, requests for approvals and other communication relating to this MoU shall be given in writing and transmitted by registered post, by prepaid registered mail by courier service or by facsimile transmission to the registered address of the Parties stated in the preamble to this MoU. No modification or amendment to this MoU and no waiver of any of the terms and conditions here of shall be valid or binding unless made in writing and duly executed by both Parties.

Force Majeure:

If at any time during the continuance of this MoU, the performance by either Party under this Agreement shall be prevented or delayed by reasons of any war (whether war be declared or not), invasion, act of foreign enemy, earthquake or other acts of the forces of nature or acts of Government which could not be foreseen (hereinafter refer red to as 'Eventuality') then, neither Party shall because of such an eventuality be entitled to terminate this Agreement nor shall either Party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such nonperformance or delay in performance. Under such circumstances, the contractual completion time shall be extended by a period equal to that during which such Eventuality operated plus an additional period, if any, as may be considered reasonable.
