Minutes from BOE meeting on 11/04/25 approved. Bill moved to accept. Roy 2nd. Unanimous vote yes.

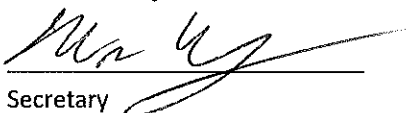
Director's Report

Provisional Ballots for approval by the Board. Jackson County BOE continues to fine tune their process.

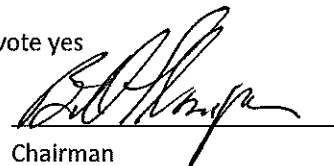
1. Total 19 Provisional ballots to review
