

Notice of Municipal Election

The Town of Highlands, Dillsboro, Sylva, Webster and Village of Forest Hills, North Carolina

A General Municipal Election will be held on 11/07/23.

Voters will be asked to show photo ID when they vote. All voters will be allowed to vote with or without ID. Voters who lack ID can get one for free from their county board of elections. Find out more at ncsbe.gov/voter-id.

Polls will be open from 6:30 am until 7:30 pm at the following Precincts:

Cullowhee (Village of Forest Hills) Village of Forest Hills Town Hall, 97 Market Street, unit 101, Cullowhee

Sylva Dillsboro Combined (Town of Sylva) Board of Election office at the Skyland Service Center, 876 Skyland Dr, Sylva

Webster (Town of Webster) Family Resource Center, 1528 Webster Rd, Webster

The Town of Highland voters may vote absentee or One Stop in Jackson County and in Macon County on Election Day.

Absentee ballots are allowed. Requests for an absentee ballot by mail must be made on the 2023 State Board Absentee Ballot Request Form available on the NC State Board of Elections website and at the Jackson County Board of Elections office. The completed and signed form must be received in the Jackson County Board of Elections office by 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, October 31st. Voted Absentee ballots must be received back in the Board of Elections office or postmarked by 5:00 pm on 11/07/2023 and in the office by 11/13/2023. The Board will meet on October 3,10,17,24, and 31st at 1:00pm. The Absentee Board meeting will be at the JC Board of Elections office.

One-stop voting will be held in the Board of Elections Office starting Wednesday, October 19th and ending Saturday November 4th. One-stop voting hours are M-F 8:00am- 5:00pm and Saturday, November 4th 8:00am-3:00pm. Non-registered persons wishing to register and vote after the registration deadline on Friday, October 12th may appear in person at the one-stop absentee voting site, complete the voter registration application form, and provide proof of residence by presenting valid documents showing current name and address. The meeting to count approved absentee ballots on Election Day is at 2:00pm.

Canvass Day will be held at 11:00 am in the Board of Elections office in Sylva on 11/17/2023.
