Nine Media Corporation and Radio Philippines Network (RPN) under Warner Bros. Discovery Asia-Pacific's license jointly owned CNN Philippines, a free-to-air television network that launched on March 16, 2015. It replaced 9TV and operated until its cessation of operations on January 31, 2024. The network featured English as its main language, with Filipino used for select programs like News Night, Newsroom, Balitaan, Eat Bulaga!, PBA, and Updates. CNN Philippines maintained a local programming hub at the Worldwide Corporate Center in Mandaluyong, analog transmitter at RPN's compound in Quezon City, and digital transmission facilities in Antipolo. Rival The network absorbed financial losses and ceased operations on January 31, 2024. Its terrestrial channel space was replaced by RPTV, while news operations and assets were integrated into Nine Media's indirect parent, Broadreach Media Holdings, to form NewsWatch Plus. that said: The global news gathering power of CNN combined with the local perspective Nine Media Corporation brings enables us to provide first-class news and information to millions of Filipinos in a way that we have not been able to previously. I couldn't be happier to welcome CNN Philippines to the CNN family.[5][7] Solar News Channel transitioned from SBN Channel 21 to RPN Channel 9 in December 2013 to improve signal and cater a wider audience. The channel phased out its "Solar" branding on newscasts as it distanced itself from majority stockholder Wilson Tieng. In August 2014, the Solar brand was retired after the ALC Group of Companies bought out the Tiengs' stake. Solar News was rebranded as 9News with retained programming and personnel. The channel's lineup expanded to include new programs such as Kids Weekend and TV Mass for the Homebound. However, in September 2014, a controversy erupted when a news crew was allegedly involved in violating traffic rules while on assignment. The incident led to disciplinary actions against the driver and his reporter and cameraman. In October 2014, Cabangon-Chua announced their partnership with the Turner Broadcasting System's Cable News Network (CNN). As part of the transition to CNN Philippines, 9TV temporarily used a green screen in its news studio in December 2014. CNN Philippines launched on March 16, 2015, after several weeks of preparation. The channel adopted the CNN graphic package from NBC and CBS programs in February. Home Shopping Network and Kids Weekend block were dropped that month. Foreign news was also replaced by CNN produced content. The network's initial broadcast had a standard definition format, but it later switched to widescreen. By Holy Week 2015, full-time broadcasts on widescreen format began. The channel is the first free-to-air TV channel in the Philippines to use a widescreen aspect ratio of 14:9. President Reggie Calura and Jng Magsaysay left the network in September 2015 following staff reductions. Armie Jarin-Bennett took over as Managing Editor on November 2, 2015. The channel updated its station bumpers in February 2016 with a new style and color scheme. CNN Philippines Network underwent significant changes following its rebranding from Solar News Channel. They updated their theme music and added new programs, including the Philippine edition of New Day, which replaced Nightly News. CNN Philippines also launched its first-ever newscast in Filipino, Balitaan, anchored by Pinky Webb. The network phased out current affairs shows that debuted under Solar News Channel and former CNN shows to make room for newer staple programming like Smerconish and more news content. In 2016, CNN Sans was implemented as the on-air graphics font, replacing Helvetica, and was later used in promos, infomercials, and revamped bumpers. Some HLN-produced programs, such as Morning Express and The Daily Share, were removed from the local lineup during major network coverage but returned due to the premiere of new CNN International programming. Amanpour was initially aired on special occasions but gained its own stand-alone broadcast in 2016, featuring Christiane Amanpour interviewing Philippine senators. CNN Philippines made changes after appointing Armie Jarin-Bennett as president in October 2016. This included airing more CNN International shows, like The Art of Movement and Vital Signs with Dr. Sanjay Gupta. A mid-morning Filipino newscast was added to Newsroom, hosted by Ruth Cabal, replacing Serbisyo All Access in February. Additional political shows premiered, such as Political Insider with Gilbert Remulla, but it got axed in July 2017 due to controversy surrounding the host's opinions on President Rodrigo Duterte. CNN Philippines Network News was replaced with News Night featuring Pia Hontiveros in March 2017. The network also introduced a new slogan "At the Heart of The Story" for promo use only. In April 2017, they switched to a widescreen format. A weekend morning bloc was launched on September 1, 2018, with cartoons and an infotainment show called KidDo. This included a junior edition of Newsroom hosted by teenagers. On November 13, 2019, CNN Philippines announced plans to air selected NBA games over the weekends as a temporary measure after the expiration of broadcast rights previously held by Solar Entertainment and ABS-CBN Sports. CNN Philippines's broadcast operations were affected by several circumstances in recent years. Initially, the network's broadcast rights were pending evaluation due to a joint bid from ABS-CBN Sports and Cignal TV/ESPN5. This led to a temporary halt in broadcasting in December 2019. In 2020, CNN Philippines faced two more instances of going off-air due to COVID-19 cases among its staff. The network resumed operations after implementing health protocols and ensuring the safety of its employees. On January 10, 2022, the channel went dark again due to limited staffing and health protocol implementation. However, it returned to broadcasting on January 11. In December 2023, TV5 Network partnered with Nine Media Corporation to broadcast selected games from the Philippine Basketball Association (PBA) and Eat Bulaga! on CNN Philippines, starting in January 2024. Unfortunately, Nine Media Corporation and CNN mutually agreed to terminate their brand licensing agreement ahead of its expiration date due to financial losses and poor ratings. This led to the shutdown of live news productions effective immediately and the eventual closure of CNN Philippines on January 31, 2024. The network's employees received a severance package and salary for the whole month of February. The final interstitial "A Moment of Serenity" played before the channel signed off for the last time at 10:00 p.m. Its last program aired was an episode of Building Bridges. In February 2024, RPTV was launched, featuring programming from TV5 and One PH, along with reruns of Nine Media's current affairs programs. In June 2024, NewsWatch Plus, a digital multicasting news service, was formally announced by CNN Philippines' news anchors and reporters. The service is a revival of RPN's flagship newscast NewsWatch. In the past, CNN Philippines had notable achievements. In April 2016, it won six awards from the Golden Dove Awards, including Best Newscaster Award for Mitzi Borromeo. In June 2016, it was recognized as Television Station of the Year in the Rotary Club of Manila Journalism Awards. Two of its news programs received recognition from the Asian Academy Creative Awards in October 2020. "The Source with Pinky Webb" won Best Current Affairs Programme or Series, while "The Final Word with Rico Hizon" won Best News Programme. In January 2016, CNN Philippines conducted a DTT testing using ISDB-T on UHF Channel 19. In 2017, Nine Media Corporation and RPN acquired the UHF transmitter complex in Antipolo to prepare for digital television implementation in 2024. CNN PH broadcasts local news and international reports from the CNN U.S. and CNNI reporters pool. It also airs and produces current affairs and lifestyle programs with different local production outfits. Select programs from CNN U.S. and HLN are aired, mainly during overnight hours. The channel occasionally broadcasts breaking stories and special events via the US or international feed, such as the Paris and Brussels terrorist attacks, rescuing trapped cave survivors in Thailand, New Year's Eve, select US presidential speeches, and US presidential election coverage. Rico Hizon Moves to ANC and SM Investments Corp., Others Switch Channels CNN Philippines Moves to Channel 9 and Later Becomes 9TV, Shuts Down After 9 Years. Nine Media owner confirms CNN Philippines shutdown. The channel will shut down on January 31 amid financial losses. This was announced by various news outlets, including Rappler and ABS-CBN News. The shutdown comes as a surprise to many, with some speculating about the reasons behind it. Others have expressed sadness at the loss of a significant media outlet in the country. In related news, RPN 9's NewsWatch is set to be revived. This was announced by Rappler on May 15, hinting that there may be a connection between the two events. 5 Plus TV5's Filipino-language news channel AksyonTV's news and current affairs programs were forced to cancel due to TV5 Network's cost-cutting measures, leaving only Radyo5 simulcasts intact with added home shopping programs. In response, Cignal launched One News, a 24-hour satellite news channel combining the news content of MediaQuest-owned companies, including News5. AksyonTV reformatted its programs in 2017 by airing reruns of American series and movie blocks, replacing live sports programming. Following TV5's relaunch as 5 in February 2018, AksyonTV was rebranded as 5 Plus on January 13, 2019, focusing on "atypical sports" programming with ESPN5 coverage. The channel targeted a younger audience and carried additional news content. Later, selected simulcast programs were moved to One PH, effectively bifurcating AksyonTV into two separate channels. In June 2019, Jane Basas took over as president and CEO of TV5 and Cignal, moving 5's morning sports programming to 5 Plus. The vacated morning block was used for reruns and movie blocks. On March 7, 2020, the channel was officially dissolved, with One Sports taking over its channel space. Main article: List of programs broadcast by AksyonTV/5 Plus 5 Plus is now airing sports events, including those from the NFL and NCAA (U.S.), after reformatting its daytime lineup that affected their schedules. This change led to NFL games being aired on a delayed schedule during the Southeast Asian Games in 2019. The channel's rebranding as One Sports was announced in March 2020. Manny Pangilinan, a prominent figure in the Philippines, is closely tied to the country's television drama industry. He has worked with various networks, including DWNB-TV, Radio Mindanao Network, Nation Broadcasting Corporation, and TeleRadyo Serbisyo, among others. Pangilinan has also been involved with GMA Network, a major Philippine broadcasting company.
