Secretary's Report (Billy Hatchell): Feb 2026 tournament results/winners posted to TCSGA website and FB. March 2026 tournament registration cards (Traces GC) were uploaded to the TCSGA website and Facebook page.

Champion Golfer of the Year: Steve Lylers has developed an Excel program to calculate the Champion Golfer of the Year points. January's tournament at Wyboo GC has been inputted.
