Death Valley Overland Adventure Tour

November 27-30, 2025

Cost: \$799.00 PER VEHICLE

Three days and nights of off-road adventuring with no pavement in sight. Death Valley is iconic, fabulously scenic, and the areas we explore are very remote. This tour includes three days and nights exploring the largest National Park in the lower 48 States. Over 80-percent of this beautiful park can only be seen while driving off-road. Off-Road Safety Academy takes you to the best locations in the park. Sand dunes, canyons, hot springs, playas where rocks mysteriously move, craters, mines, and high-altitude trails are all part of this adventure tour. This tour visits Saline Valley, Hunter Mountain, Hidden Valley, Tea Kettle Junction, Racetrack, and Ubehebe Crater. I've been off-roading in Death Valley since 1970, and I can assure you that no other route in the park allows you to see more diversity in three days. The tour begins off of Highway 395 and ends near the ghost town of Ballarat.

Most of the remote backcountry cabins visited on this tour can NOT be found on a map. Someone has to lead you to them. The six cabins you will visit on this tour are special "secret spots" in and around the Death Valley area. Some are Adopt-A-Cabins, carefully nurtured and kept very clean by volunteer groups. Once you learn how to find these

wonderful Adopt-A-Cabins, you will want to return to them time and again to stay overnight. All of the cabins visited are historic remnants of the miners that carved out a living in the area.

This exciting eightnight, nine-day adventure tour features



a scenic southern route through Baja. You will be driving along the Sea of Cortez, the Pacific Coast, and through the middle of the Baja Peninsula. You will encounter wondrous landscapes, authentic cultural experiences and food, stunning ocean campsites, original Spanish missions, and relaxed evening campfires. On the tour, we will reach the Bay of Conception as our southern-most point. The tour cost includes a Grey Whale encounter on Scammon's Lagoon

using a certified boat operator near the wonderful town of Guerrero Negro.During our inland wanderings, we will visit a famous Baja cave paintings area.

New radiocarbon techniques dates these paintings back 9,000 to 11,000 years, roughly the same time as the end of the first ice age. Experts say that these pictographs are the oldest on the North American Continent.

Majestic Mojave Road – An Overlanding Backcountry Adventure

March 19-22, 2026

Cost: \$799.00 per vehicle



After a three-year pause, Off-Road Safety Academy is again returning to the Mojave National Preserve area. The iconic Mojave Road is an overlanding adventure you simply must do at least once in your life. This tour familiarizes you with

the region and implants in you a

strong desire to return again and again.

The Mojave Road was first used by Indians to transport goods from the southwest to trade with the Chumash and other coastal tribes. The route later served the cause of westward expansion.

Military forts were established along the route to protect key water sources and provide assistance for travelers.



This off-road adventure includes 3-nights of remote camping. The tour meets near Laughlin, NV and officially begins at the southern National Preserve boundary. On the third day, the tour officially ends at the northern Preserve boundary near I-15 west of Las Vegas. Specific sites visited along the route include Fort Piute, various petroglyphs, Government Holes, Marl Springs, and the famous lava tube caves.
