
Upcoming Recreational 4WD Safety Courses (And a Teaser; read to the end)

Introduction to 4WD Off-Roading



.January 24-25, 2026

Cost: \$799.00 per driver

Location: Prairie City State Vehicular Recreation Area (Near Sacramento, CA)

This is Off-Road Safety Academy's two-day 4WD course. (Beginning and advanced drivers will find the course useful or your money back!) Want to learn more about your street-legal 4-Wheel Drive vehicle? Want to improve your off-road driving skills? Interested in keeping you and your loved ones safe while off-roading? Off-Road Safety Academy™ will safely teach you in one weekend what it takes most people years to learn on their own.

Course Goal: The goal of this course is to put you on a path to safely and ecologically off-road on a variety of different terrains. This course is taught assuming you may travel off-road SOLO (no other vehicles with you), REMOTE, and INTERNATIONAL. This is the worst possible off-roading context. If you are

taught to this level, then you'll be more ready to challenge yourself with different terrains, environments, and situations. Although it is always best to off-road with other vehicles, this is not always possible or desired. Upon completion of this course, you begin to understand the limitations of your vehicle and your driving skills allowing you to intelligently choose excursions and trails to match the capabilities of your vehicle and your off-roading knowledge and skill.

Prerequisite: None (Except a desire to learn and have FUN!)

Length of Course: Two days; 8:30am to 5:00 pm.

Target Audience: All novice or experienced off-road drivers that want to learn the basics of four-wheeling in relative safety and comfort. This course is for the owners of any new or used street-legal 4-Wheel Drive or electric AWD vehicle (e.g., Jeeps, Explorers, Hummers, Land Rovers, Xterras, Land Cruisers, Pathfinders, Sprinters, trucks, Rivians, Cybertrucks, etc.). Even experienced owners of off-road vehicles are welcome at this course. During this course, you'll begin to learn how to off-road on your own and launch backcountry adventures in relative safety and comfort.

Have a driving partner? If you regularly offroad with a spouse, friend, or partner enroll them in the courses also. Should you, the primary driver, become ill, injured, tired, or need help when traversing challenging terrain, an equally knowledgeable and skillful driver can be a real benefit.

Vehicle Requirements: Any reliable street-legal 4-Wheel Drive with 2-speed 4WD transfer case. (Must be able to shift into a 4-Low gearing.) Electric vehicles with AWD and designed for offroading are also invited. (Rivian, Cybertruck, Hummer, etc.)




Length of Course: Two days. 8:30 am to 5:00 pm

Target Audience: All off-roaders. It is recommended (not required) that enrollees complete the Discovery course prior to taking this course.

Vehicle Requirements: Any reliable street-legal 4-Wheel Drive with 2-speed 4WD transfer case. (Must be able to shift into a 4-Low gearing.) Electric vehicles with AWD and designed for off-roading are also invited. (Rivian, Cybertruck, Hummer, etc.)

Accessory Recovery Equipment: All you need to bring to the course is your vehicle and a pair of leather gloves. You do not need to have a winch on your vehicle to take the course. However, bring whatever recovery equipment you may already have. If you do not have recovery equipment, it's best not to purchase equipment for the course. I will show you, and allow you to use during the course, the very best equipment you'll want to purchase.

4WD Outfitter & Guide Course

Interested in learning how to organize, schedule, market, and safely lead off-road adventure tours? Not to mention, make money?

I know there's a few of you out there that are interested, because I

regularly get asked the question, "How can I learn to lead off-road adventure tours like you?"

I now have an answer to this question. I've developed an educationally valid

curriculum for those that want to learn how to lead backcountry adventure tours. This is a professional certification course.

The five-day course will, in part, include these topics:

- The business of leading adventure tours
- How to incorporate your new business
- Securing permits to conduct professional tours on United States public lands (State Properties. BLM: Special Recreation Permits. National Parks: Commercial Use Authorizations)
- The legal aspects of being in charge
- Securing liability insurance
- Developing a Risk Management Manual
- Organizing the sale of spots on tours & refunds
- Outfitting your leader vehicle
- Must have equipment and accessories
- Remote communication car-to-car & emergency communications
- Reconnoitering a backcountry route
- Leading basecamp and overlanding-style tours
- Teaching 4WD basics while leading off-road tours
- Problem solving in the field
- Customer service
- Building "community" on adventure tours

The course is officially scheduled for April 20-24, 2026, at Prairie City SVRA, just outside of Sacramento, California. Requisites (pre or post) for 4WD Outfitter & Guide certification are:

- 1) Completion of Off-Road Safety Academy's Introduction to 4WD Off-Roading and Recovery Course (or proof of the knowledge and skills included in both courses).
- 2) Wilderness First Aid Provider, Responder, or Instructor Certification.

For those needing Wilderness First Aid (WFA) certification, we will conduct a two-day Wilderness First Aid Provider course designed exclusively for vehicle-supported adventurers on April 25-26 (the weekend after the 4WD Outfitter & Guide course). This WFA course will also be open to the general public.

Cost of the 4WD Outfitter & Guide course and WFA course is being determined.
