Metal detector enthusiasts compete for more than \$10,000 at Diggin' Bonham By Allen Rich Apr 3, 2023

Bonham, Texas -- Metal detector enthusiasts from five states were on the prowl in Powder Creek Park April 1, 2023 as they competed for more than \$10,500 in a seeded hunt called Diggin' Bonham, an event sponsored by Visit Bonham and Bonham Economic Development Corporation.



All 60 slots available in the seeded hunt were quickly snapped up and most competitors arrived in Bonham on Friday, March 31, reserving all local hotel rooms and filling local restaurants in anticipation of the big day.

Neighbors Place Winery hosted a welcome reception Friday night with complimentary hors d'oeuvres and soft drinks. Diggers were astonished at the hospitality as the City of Bonham went all out to welcome our visitors.

Registered treasure hunters signed in Saturday morning at Bonham Visitors Center and picked up a complimentary grab-and-go breakfast before heading for the 9:00 a.m. hunt at Powder Creek Park.





The hunters paused for lunch and then grabbed their metal detectors and headed out for the second dig of the day in a different section of Powder Creek Park.

An exciting day of competing for more than \$10,500 came to an end at 4:00 p.m. with the closing ceremony.
