 - * Defied the Open Meetings Act purpose by not providing sufficient information about the intent to vote on specific properties on meeting agendas.
 - * Failed to have any public discussion about the sale of public Open Space lands.
 - * Reneged on promise to let Voters decide via a referendum.
- * Supported Supervisor Balich position that he boldly stated he did not want to discuss plans in public and would let the public know later what deals he made.
 - * Removed information about Open Space properties from the Township website.
 - * Appear to have taken a Vow of Silence versus working for Transparency.
