Teacher Training

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Robert was introduced to teacher training early in his career, in 2002, in the Los Angeles Unified School District's Continuing Education program. As a fully-credentialed Adult ESL instructor (see Teaching Experience: Adult ESL) he was required to attend teacher Continuing Education programs and submit lesson plan ideas for other teachers based on his classroom experience. These lesson plans were peer reviewed and evaluated by teaching supervisors.

Starting in 2004, as a full-time instructor at Meito High School (see Teaching Experience: Secondary School), Robert was required to conduct sessions with Japanese English teachers in ESL teaching techniques used in Los Angeles public schools.



In 2009-2010, Robert was a Visiting Lecturer in the Education Department at Nagoya University of Arts and Sciences. He taught a special program for teachers in how to teach Kid's English. (see under Teaching Experience: University).



This included having the student teachers create a faux kindergarten in which they not only had to make lessons, but also deal with parents.

Robert relocated to Chongqing China in 2012. He did teacher training at both Owen Education and the Chongqing Stilwell Foreign Language School.

At Stilwell, Robert trained teachers in Vocabulary and Reading Comprehension instruction.
