








Free at last, Ed Kincade removes his graduation gown, after posing for the usual two dozen family pictures.



Epilogue

With one notable exception, since 1966 there has been a cosmopolitan adherence to values by graduating classes. Each class, at the risk of being called cynical, has realistically observed and evaluated the Malvernian's environment.

The untutored satire of one class and the apparent apathy of another have been bracketed by the intelligence of some and the creativity of others. Perhaps, what was begun as oars beating against the current has culminated in the stretching of arms to the nebulii of aesthetic fulfillment. And, even at that, it is still only a beginning.

What began as a neo-classic resurgence towards simplicity has ended in the Summer of 1971 with the neo-romantic inspiration of the "Now" generation.

But let us not restrict the Class of 1971 to a Brook Farm or a Xanadu, for theirs was not the enigmatic approach of the original dissidents. The approach of the Class of 1971 had a practicality, a reasonableness to it that dissaudes one from judging them and tempts one to admire them.

Maybe future classes will turn to another more convuluted kinescope for their yearbooks, but they will have this as an archetype of inventiveness.
