Once a week, Mrs. Peggy Schulz taught Music to this group of Seniors. Mrs. Schulz is a graduate of Villa Maria and Immaculata.

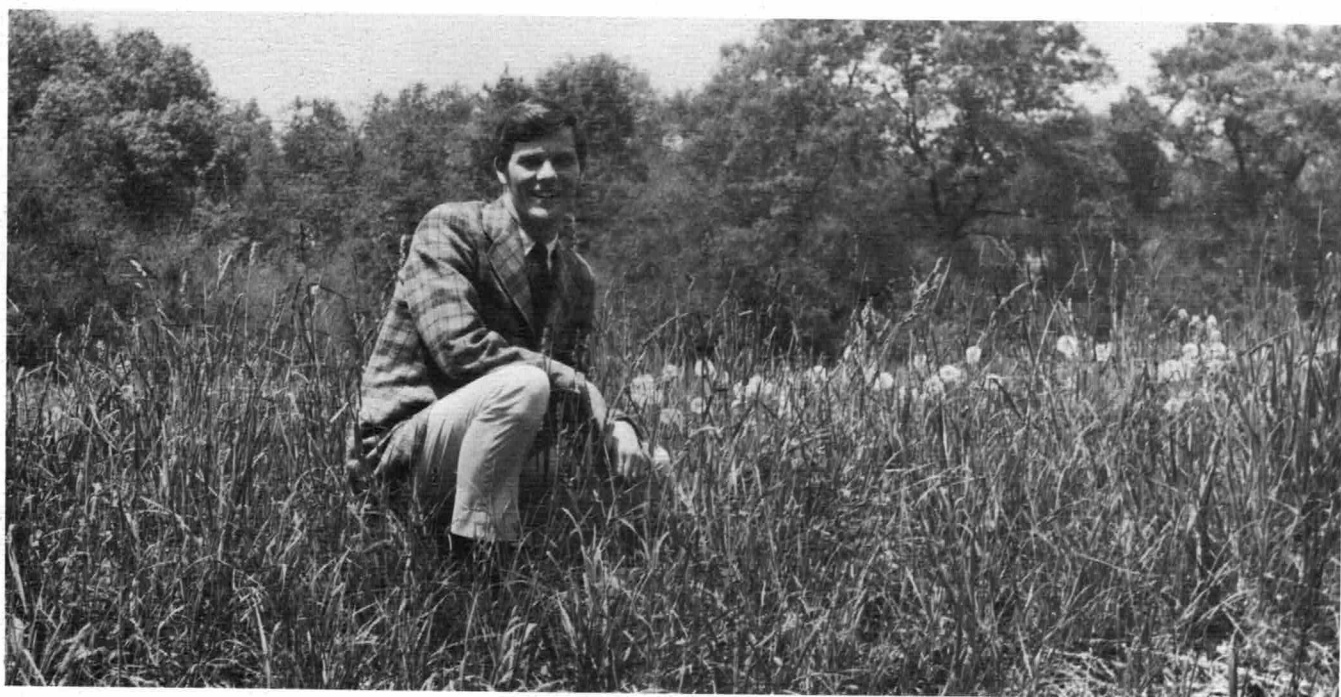


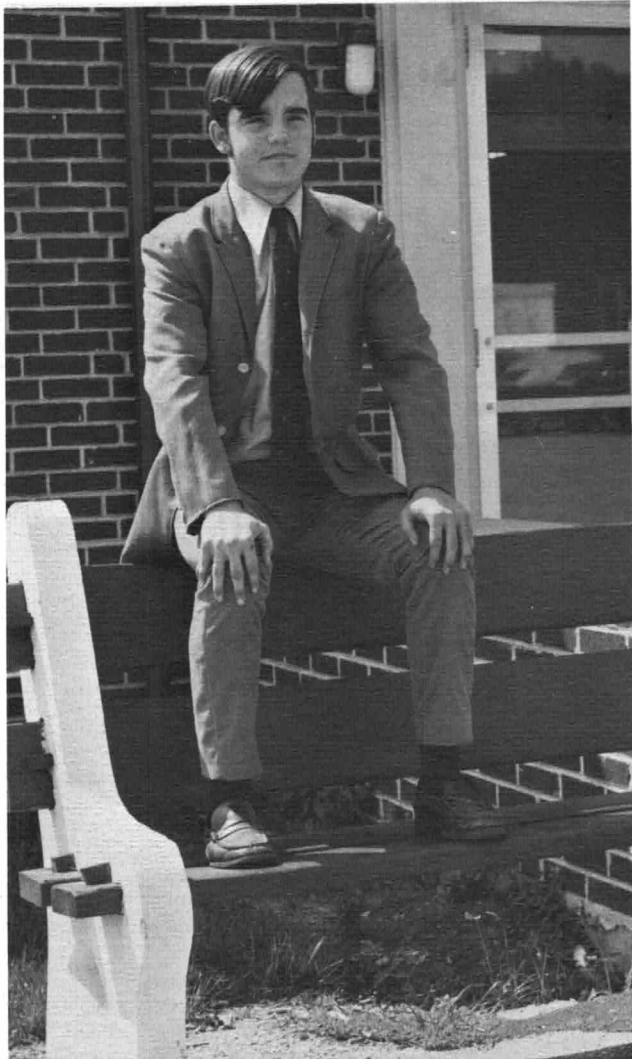
