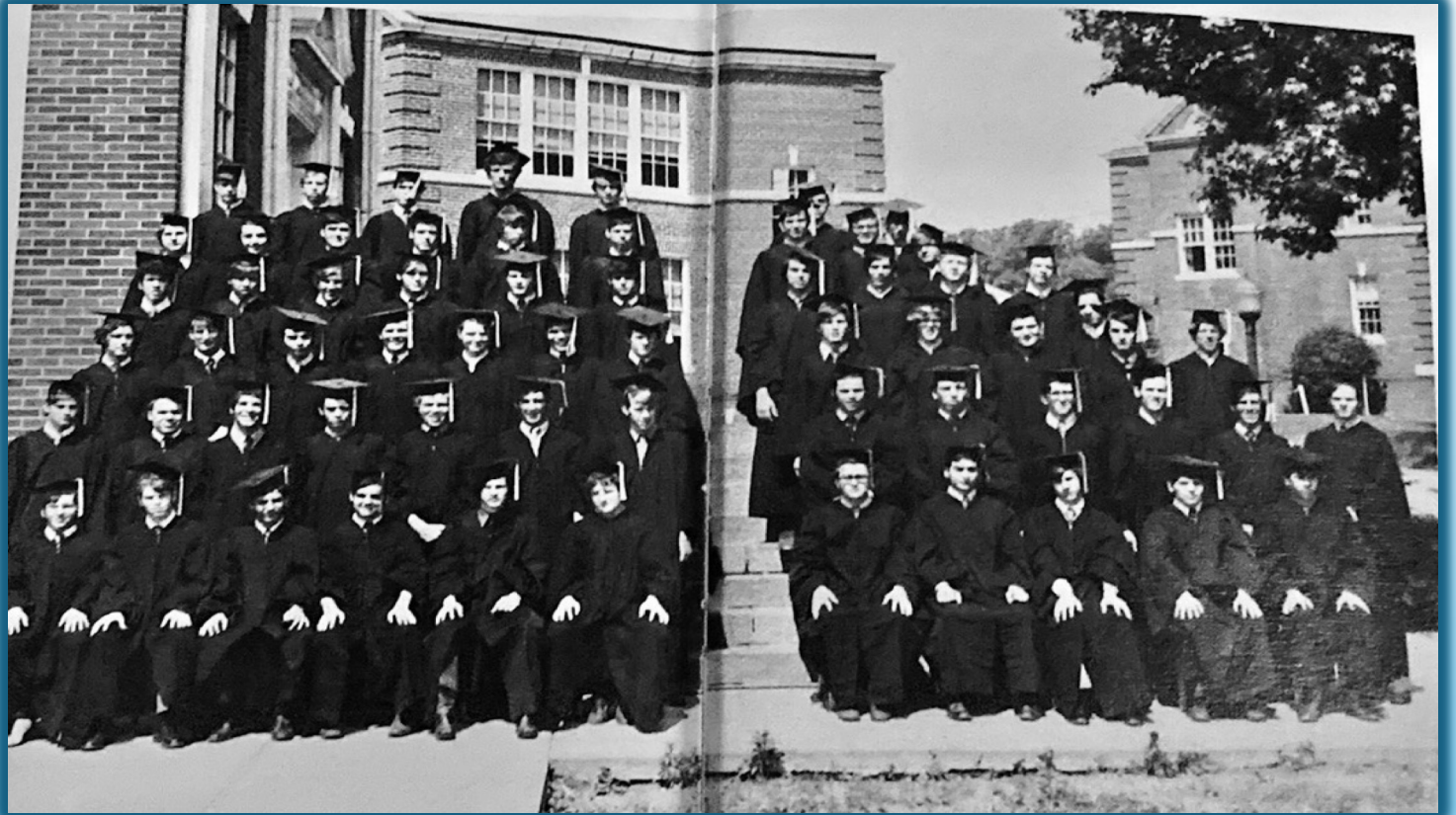

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Executive Summary

The Malvern Prep Class of 1971 is proud to present our Scholarship Fund Impact Statement. The Class of 1971 Scholarship Fund, initiated and funded in 2015 by Bill Kuharich '71, originated as an annual \$2,500 gift awarded to a Malvern Prep rising Senior who distinguished himself by embodying and exemplifying Malvern Prep values – truth, unity, love.

During the 50th Reunion of the Class of 1971 (held October 16, 2021), Bill explained the background and purpose of his annual \$2,500 gift. As a class, we decided to join Bill's charitable efforts and expand the annual gift by establishing an endowed Class of 1971 Scholarship Fund. This expanded Scholarship Fund would be used as financial aid for a rising Malvern Prep Senior whose family is experiencing financial difficulties putting his attendance during his Senior year and therefore his graduation from Malvern in jeopardy. At the same time, we determined the significant benefits to have the Malvern Prep Development Office administer the broader endowed Scholarship Fund.

With the goal of reaching the endowment level of \$135,000 (or more) in five years, the Class of 1971 immediately began working with Malvern's Development and Alumni Offices to publicize our efforts to fellow classmates, schoolmates, families, and friends of the Class of 1971. Our Community has embraced this outreach, bringing us together again.

As you will see in the Financial Performance section of this report, we have achieved our goal of an Endowed Class of 1971 Scholarship Fund in less than five years, including adding a second, Class of 1971 Scholarship. More importantly, we can make that statement because of the very generous support of our Donors - classmates, schoolmates, families, and friends of the Class of 1971 listed in the Donor's section of this report.
