Last year, we restored the tradition of special ribbons for our Great Sun Council Meetings. Back in the day, Great Sun Council meetings would be attended by hundreds of men in Indianapolis. It was a different time when you had to organize a venue large enough to house everyone, arrange for hotels, pay for per diem, etc., etc. Different types of medals would be made for the occasion. This year, our medal's ribbon is reversable, allowing a black ribbon to be worn in case you attend the funeral of one of our members.



About 30 ribbons have been ordered and are available for attendees of the Great Sun Council.

The medal below was the one given to attendees of Indiana's 1925 Great Sun Council. This took place in Indianapolis from October 20th to the 21st. It was held at the Grand Lodge hall in the Pythian Building. 795 delegates enrolled at that time. William Howard LaRue (Anderson), Ottis House (Shelbyville), Albert Hausman (Indianapolis) and were elected to Great Sachem, Great Senior Sagamore, and Great Junior Sagamore, respectively.
