

Founder's Day Challenge



Alumni Spotlight - Alex Hahn



For the undergraduate and alumni members who may or may not be familiar with you, Tell Us a little about yourself.

Mike was recognized by the national organization for the official renaming of Delta Tau's Endowment in honor of his service to our chapter.




Hayden Jaco was inducted into the Alpha Sigma Phi Hall of Fame and named the Frank F. Hargear Memorial Award recipient.
