He receives feedback from all departments, but makes decisions alone.	Clients submit paycheck stubs, community service hours, AA/NA verification sheets, and/or school schedules/forms to case manager, RECONNECT app & bring documentation to court. Follow directions of your case manager.
Rules to Remember: *Be honest. Be present. Be early. *Keep your phone charged & location ON. *Never leave your phone behind. *Phone charge at least 30%. *9:30 curfew every night *No overnight travel in phase 1. *No vaping; no energy drinks; no supplements *Do not put anything over the counter in your body without permission from lab. *Show absolute respect to all staff & peers. *Keep confidentiality of all peers & staff information. *No drugs or alcohol of any kind in your residence. *All dating/relationships cannot be secret.	Rules to Remember: *Arrive to the lab early to ensure you test on time. *Do not visit any places not approved by court staff. *All appointments, groups and court are mandatory, not optional. *You must be on time and ready to participate. All appts are EQUAL. *Read your drug court handbook and review your contract immediately. *You may not be with/around felons, probationers, active using/drinking. *Court dictates specific rules for acquaintances/friendships. *Your residence and people living in it were approved in your plea. Request changes. *Do not make life changes without discussion & court approval. *Any prescription or any over the counter substance must be preapproved. *Do not fill RX or take without speaking to therapy/gaining court approval. *Contact treatment for any side effects immediately. *Any/all medical visits must be reported immediately with official documentation. *Remember: PERMISSION NOT JUST COMMUNICATION
